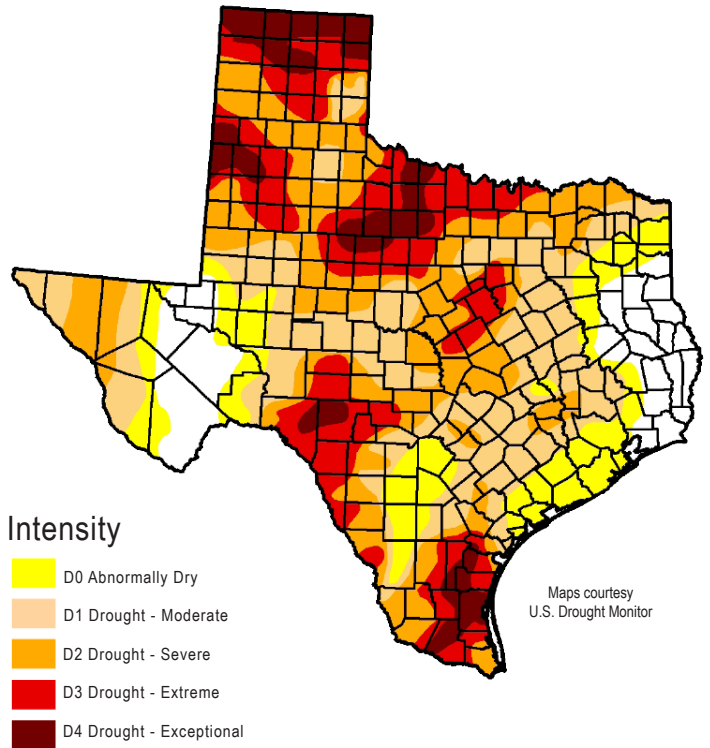


## DROUGHT CONDITIONS THIS WEEK

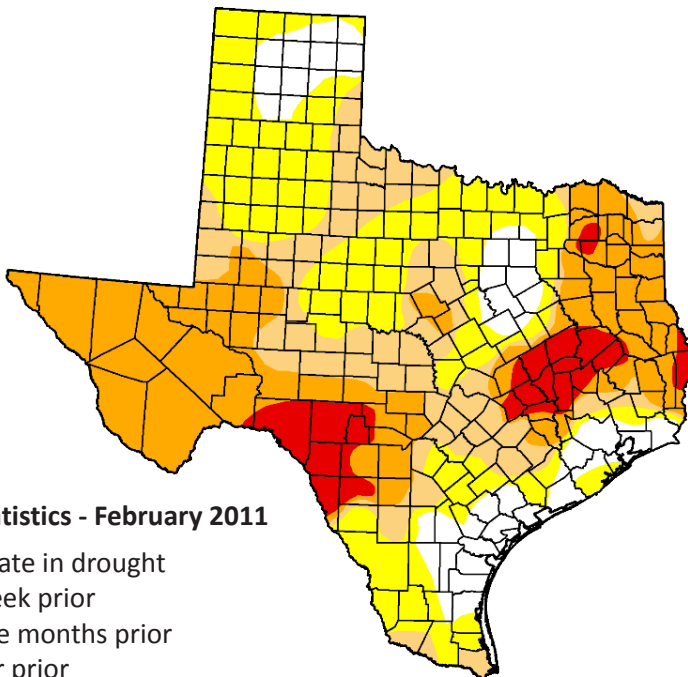
These maps compare current drought conditions to conditions at the same time in 2011. Current state-wide conditions are much worse than they were in 2011 when we were in what turned out to be the worst one-year drought on record.

### Current Drought statistics

- 89% of state currently in drought
- 90% a week ago
- 89% three months ago
- 95% a year ago



## DROUGHT CONDITIONS TWO YEARS AGO (2011)



### Drought statistics - February 2011

- 87% of state in drought
- 84% 1 week prior
- 56% three months prior
- 7% 1 year prior

### Reservoir statistics

- Statewide: currently 67% full
- 67% a week ago
- 66% three months ago
- 68% a year ago
- Normally 82% at this time

### Key reservoirs

- Amistad (Lower Rio Grande Valley area): 41%
- Choke Canyon (Corpus Christi area): 47%
- Elephant Butte (El Paso area): 10%
- Lavon (Dallas area): 62%
- Livingston (Houston area): 100%
- Meredith (Amarillo-Lubbock area): 0%
- O.H. Ivie (San Angelo-Midland-Odessa area): 22%
- Travis (Austin area): 39%
