

## DROUGHT CONDITIONS THIS WEEK

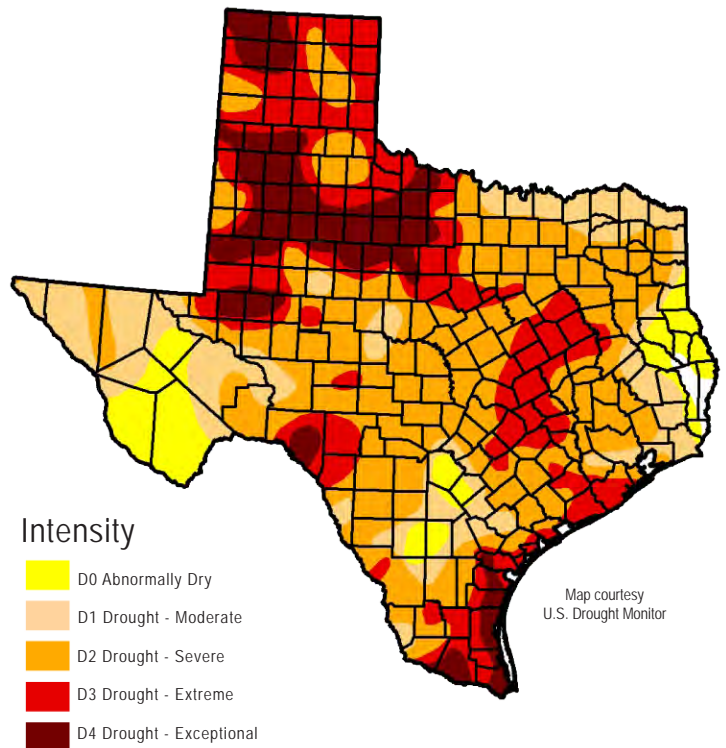
We lost almost 570,000 acre-feet of statewide reservoir storage over the last two weeks, but the broad rainfalls expected across the state this week should help improve drought conditions and hopefully increase reservoir storage. The drought outlook remains the same: Improved conditions in the east; continuing drought in the west.

### Current Drought statistics

- 99% of state currently in drought
- 99% one week ago
- 99% three months ago
- 97% one year ago

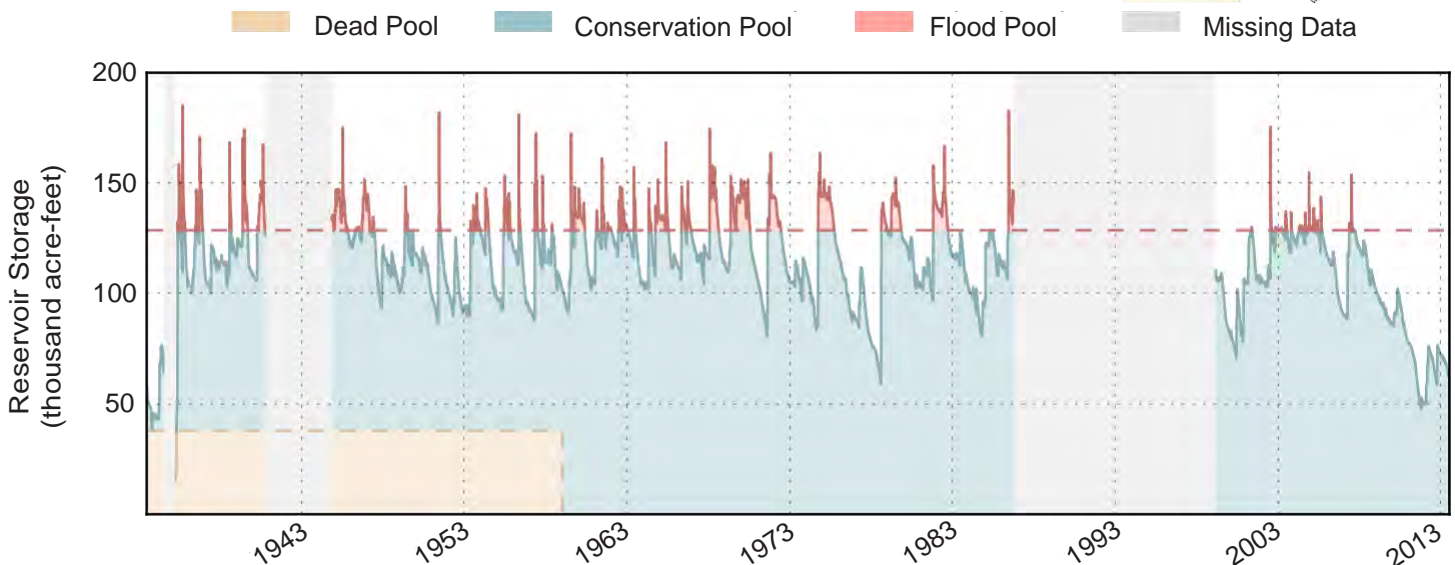
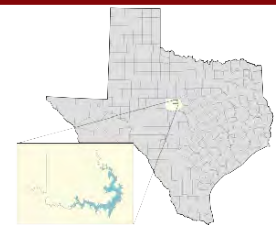
### Reservoir statistics

- 64% full statewide
- 65% full one week ago
- 66% full 3 months ago
- 75% one year ago
- 83% full historically
