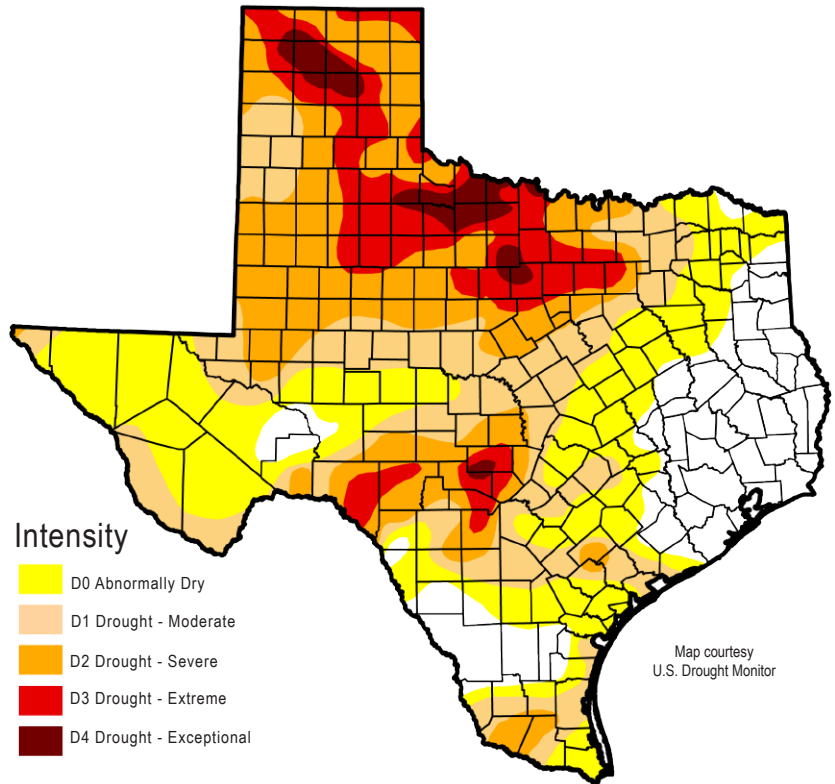


DROUGHT CONDITIONS

Drought conditions across the state showed little net change over the past week. Some areas saw improvement (Panhandle) from much-needed rains, while others experienced deteriorating conditions (portions of Central Texas, including Kerrville). Statewide reservoir storage capacity declined slightly, dropping 90,000 acre-feet or 0.3 percentage points.

Drought statistics

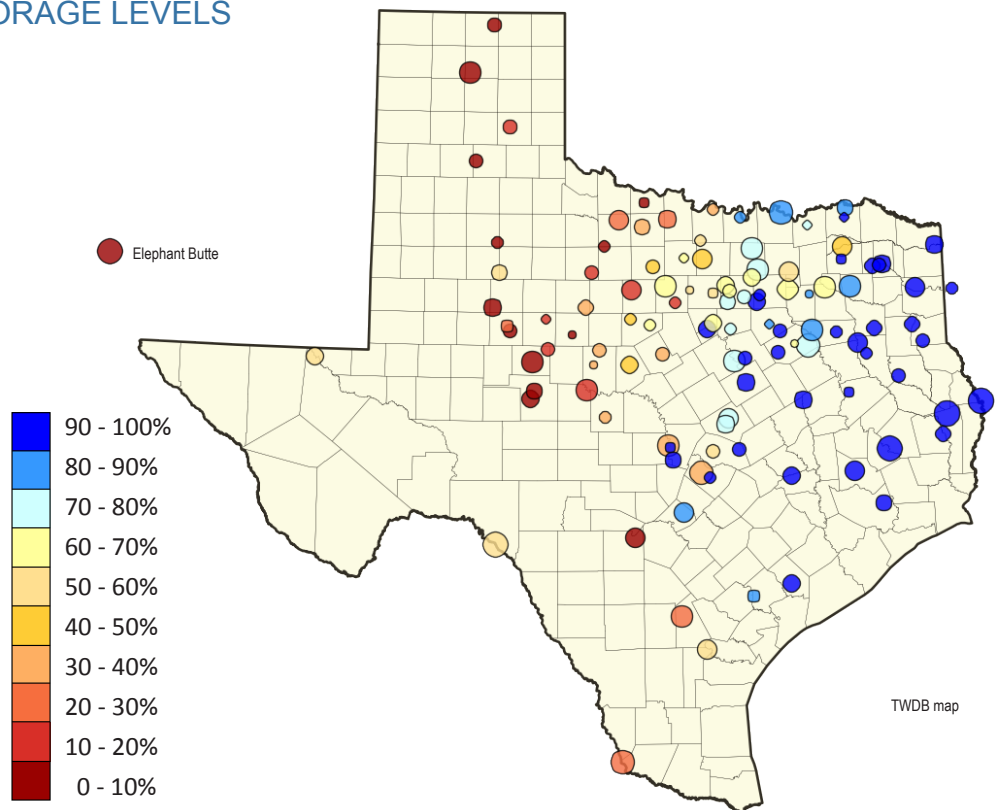
- 57% of state currently in moderate to exceptional drought
- 58% a week ago
- 83% three months ago
- 88% a year ago



STATEWIDE RESERVOIR STORAGE LEVELS

Monitored water supply reservoirs

- Currently 67% full
- 67% a week ago
- 65% three months ago
- 62% a year ago
- Normally 81% at this time
