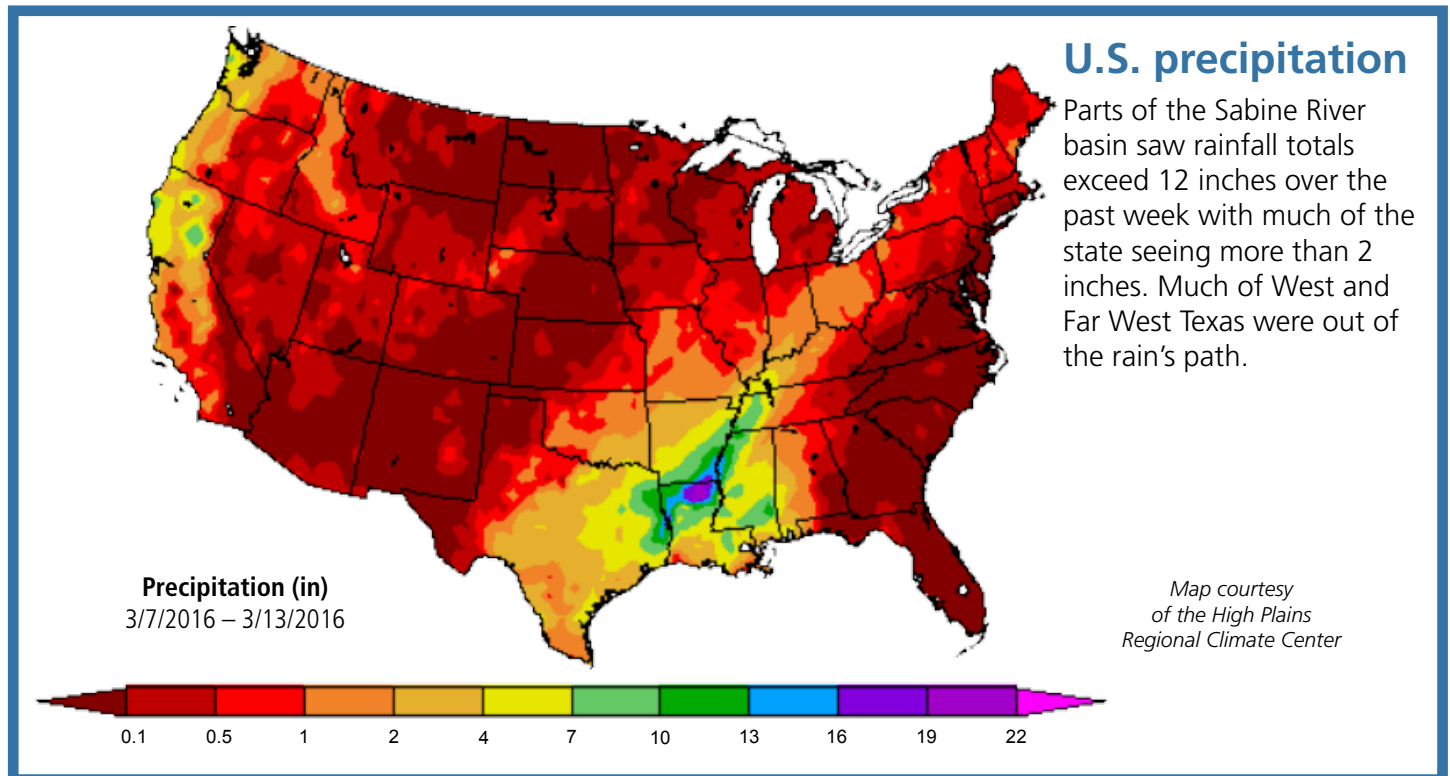
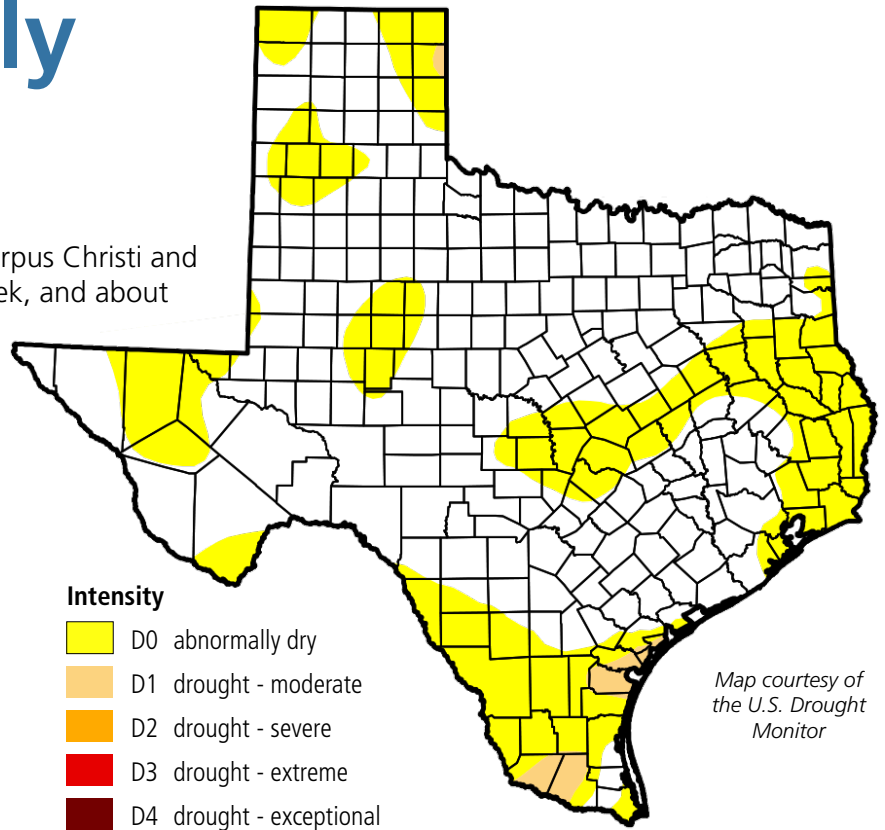

Water conditions

Slight uptick of drought conditions in the Corpus Christi and Lower Rio Grande Valley areas again this week, and about 30% of state is abnormally dry; however, this map doesn't include rainfall we received last week. The next U.S. Drought Monitor map should show improvement in dry conditions across the eastern part of the state.

Drought conditions

- ◆ 1.5% now
- ◆ 1.1% a week ago
- ◆ 0% three months ago
- ◆ 41% a year ago
