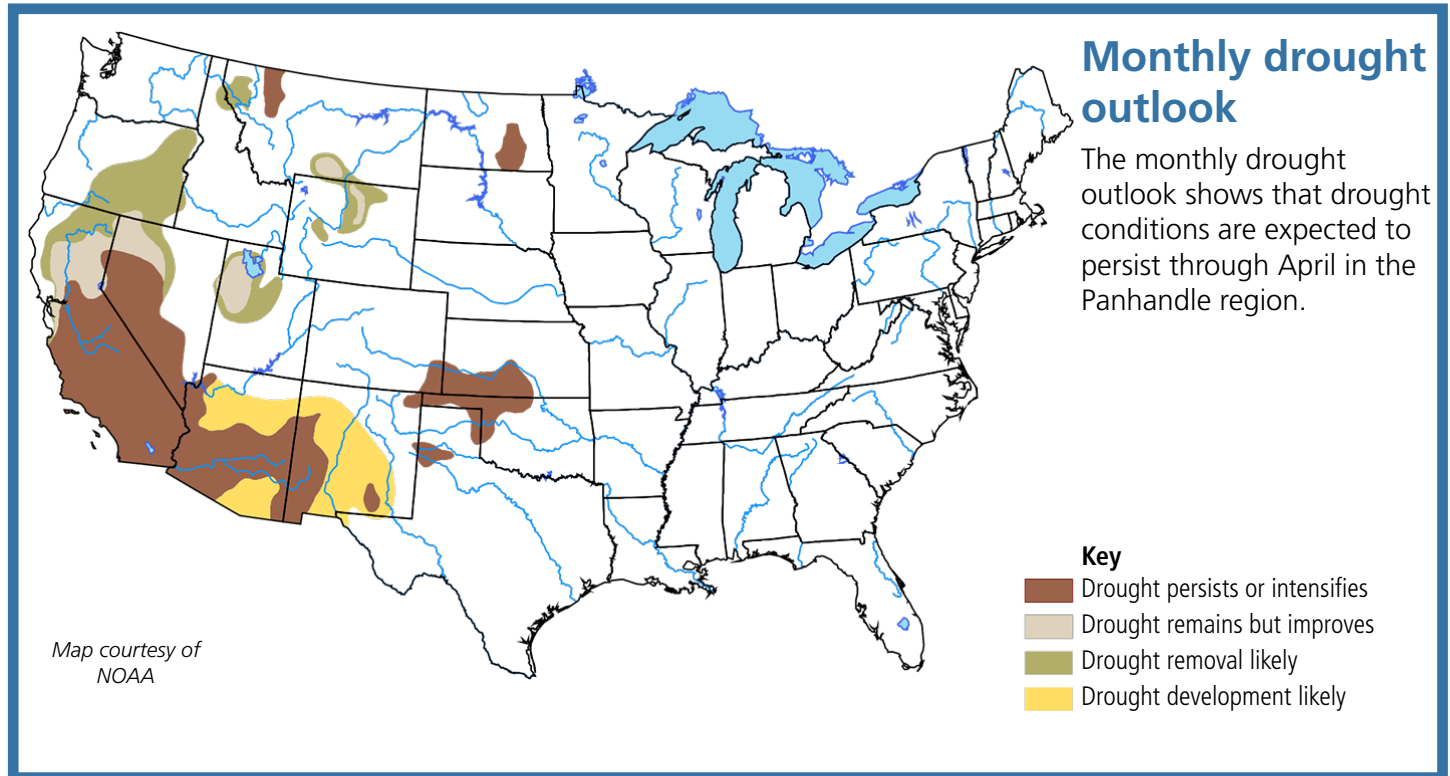
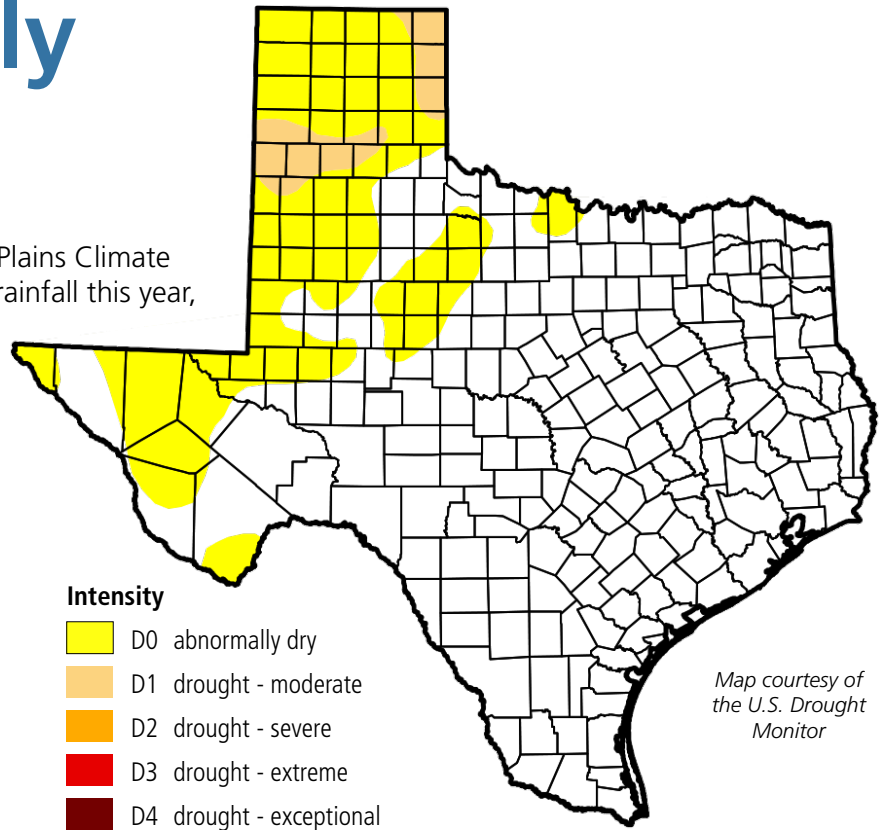

## Water conditions

A tale of two compass points: (W) The High Plains Climate Region has only gotten a third of its normal rainfall this year, the 17<sup>th</sup> driest start in 123 years; (E) The East Texas Climate Region received its second wettest March in 121 years. As these points might suggest, drought has expanded in the Panhandle.

## Drought conditions

- ◆ 3% now
- ◆ 0.7% a week ago
- ◆ 0% three months ago
- ◆ 37% a year ago
