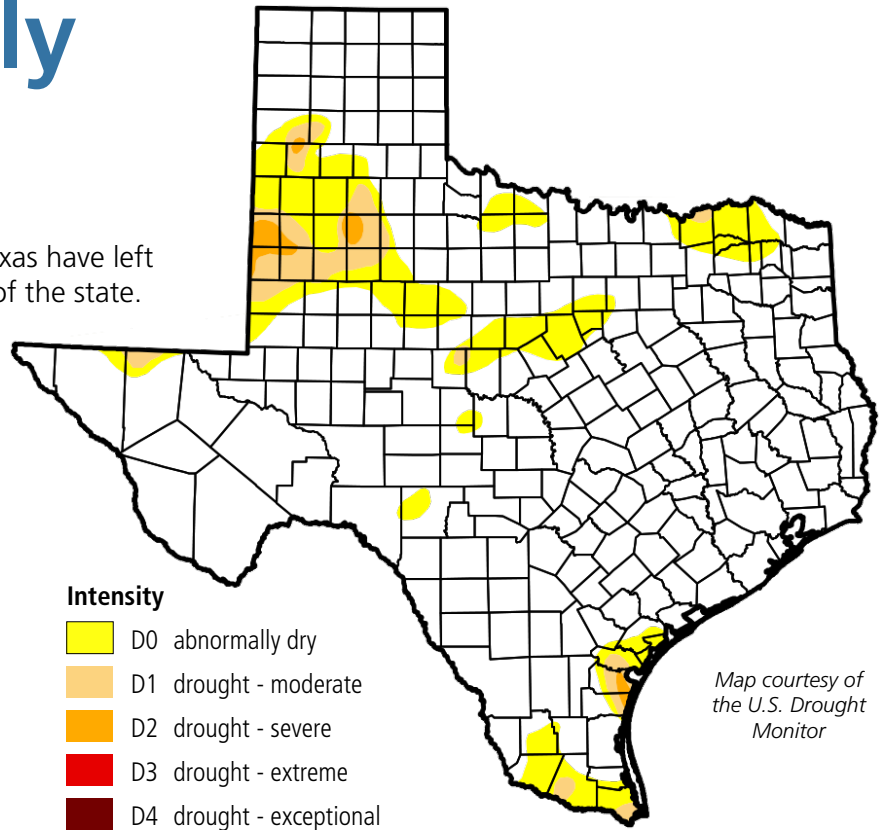

Rains that swathed through the middle of Texas have left us drought free in much of the eastern half of the state. Unfortunately, those rains missed the lower Rio Grande Valley, Corpus Christi, and Fannin County, as well as West Texas, where drought conditions worsened.

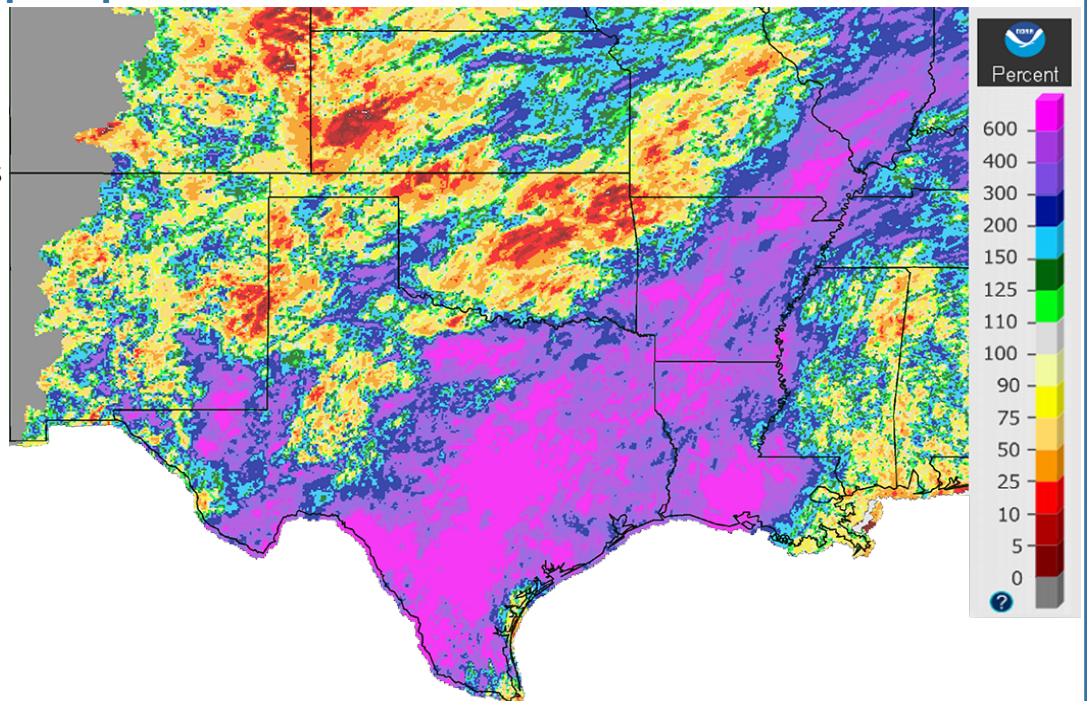
Drought conditions

This map of percent of normal rainfall over the past two weeks shows the path of the recent rains as well as the spots the rains missed.
