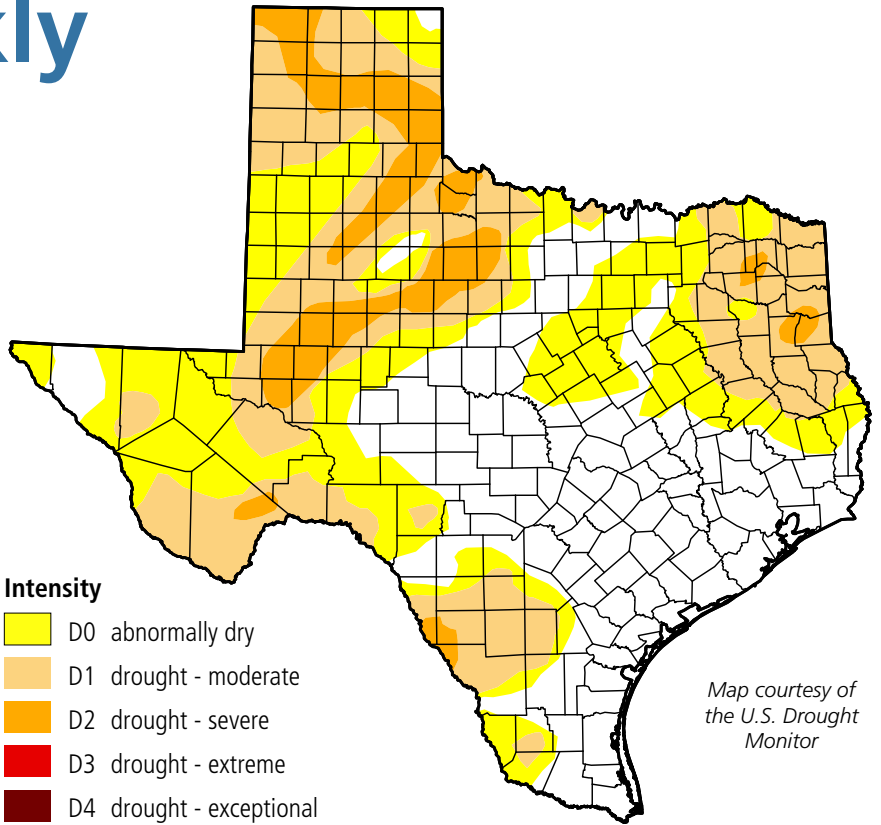

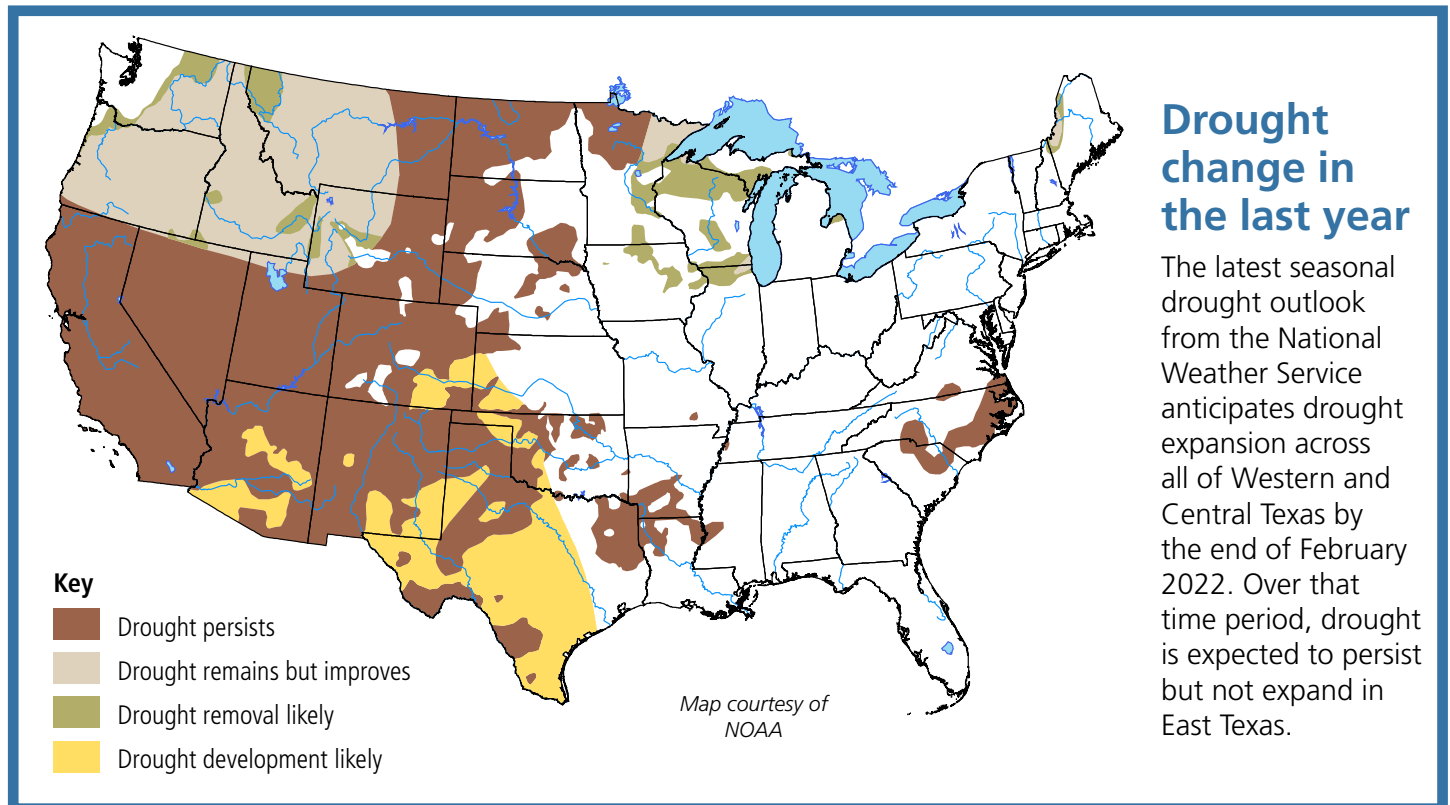
## Water conditions

Last week's drought map showed minor improvements from the previous week. However, conditions as of November 16 indicate a return to the pattern of week-to-week degradations that have occurred 10 of the last 11 weeks. Through the end of 2021, we should expect more weekly expansion in drought rather than improvements.



## Drought conditions

- ◆ 36% now
- ◆ 32% a week ago
- ◆ 1% three months ago
- ◆ 75% a year ago



## Drought change in the last year

The latest seasonal drought outlook from the National Weather Service anticipates drought expansion across all of Western and Central Texas by the end of February 2022. Over that time period, drought is expected to persist but not expand in East Texas.
