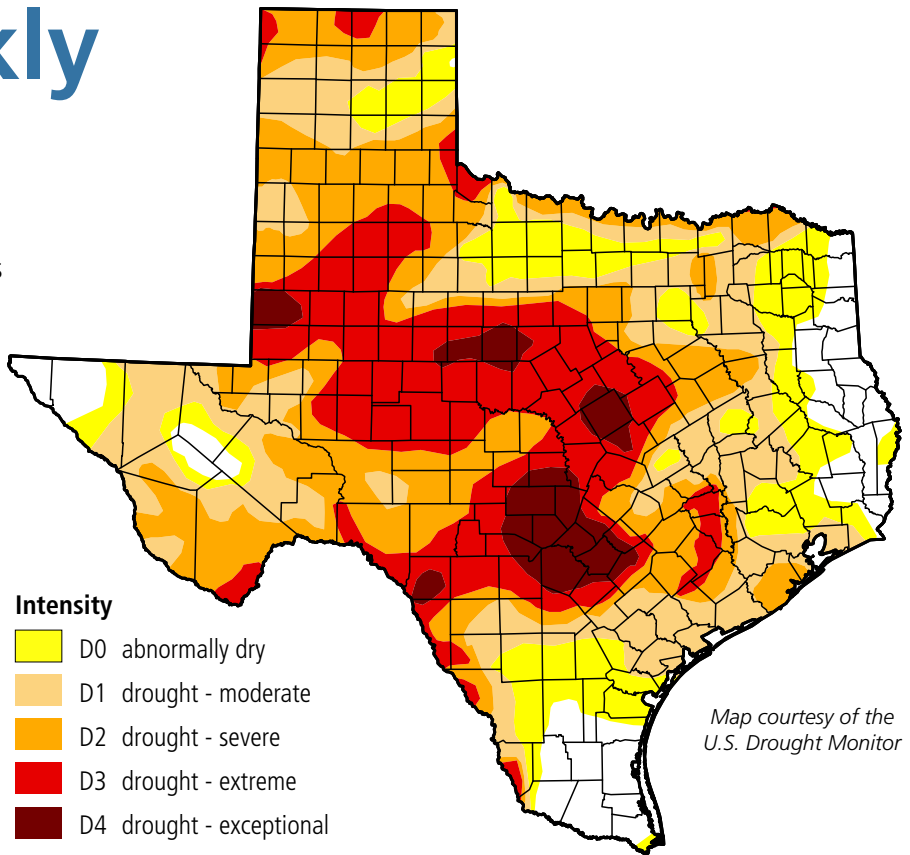

Water conditions

The drought map for August 30 conditions shows continued improvement. The area of the state impacted by extreme or worse drought contracted to 26 percent, 17 percentage points less than the previous week. The area of the state impacted by drought reached its lowest value this year.

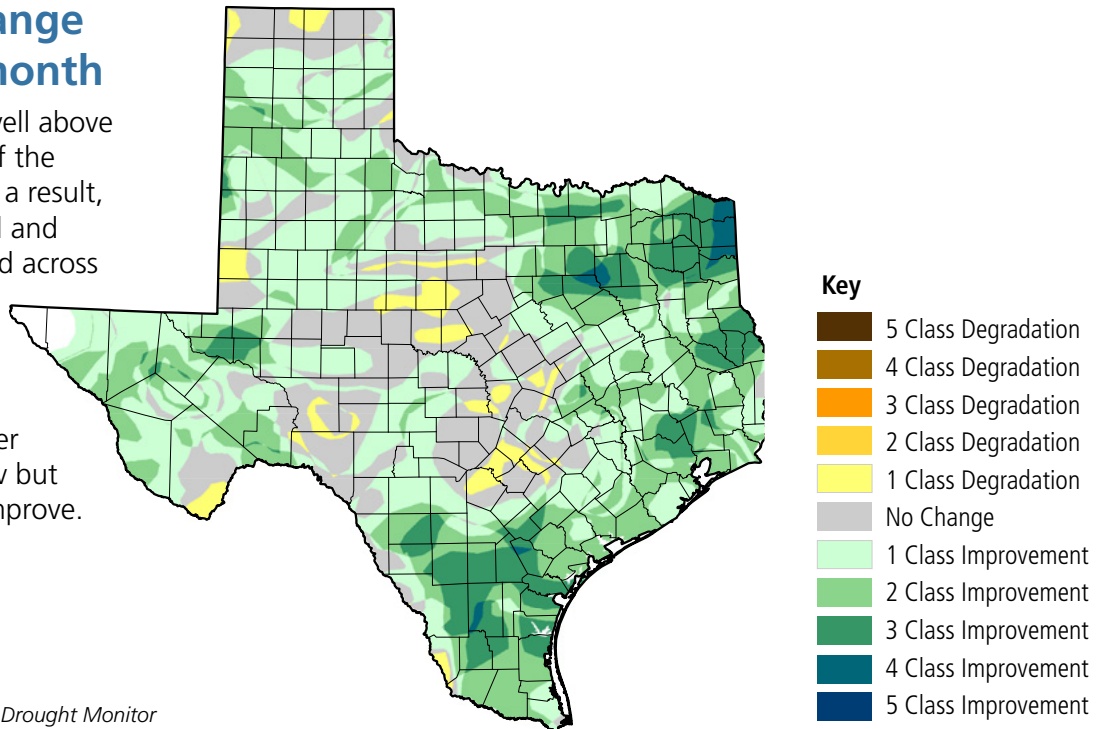
Drought conditions

- ◆ 76% now
- ◆ 87% a week ago
- ◆ 78% three months ago
- ◆ 0.8% a year ago



Drought change in the last month

Precipitation was well above average for most of the state in August. As a result, drought contracted and conditions improved across the state. Further improvements are expected during the month of September. Water supplies remain low but are beginning to improve.
