

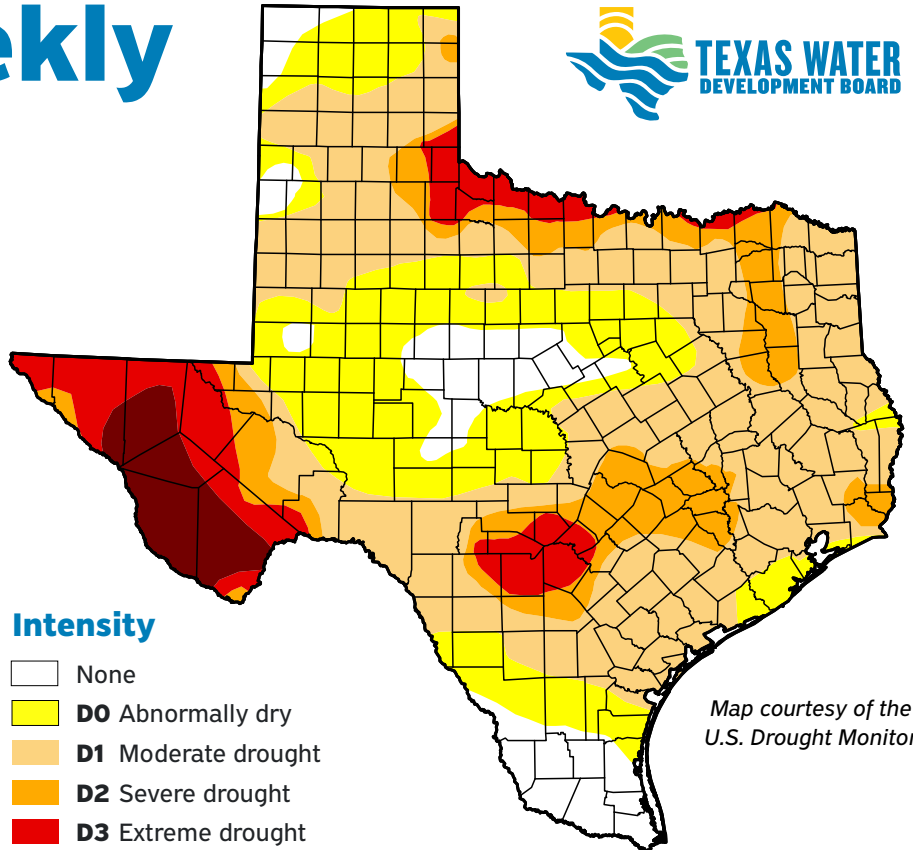

Water conditions

Unusually dry and warm conditions are taking their toll on Texas. The drought map for October 22 shows two-thirds of the state in drought. Nearly a quarter of the state is abnormally dry, poised to slip into drought in coming weeks if conditions don't change.



Drought conditions

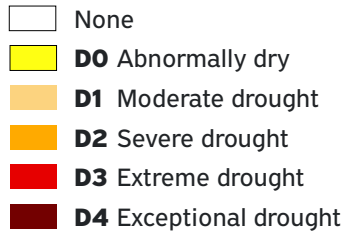

21% three months ago

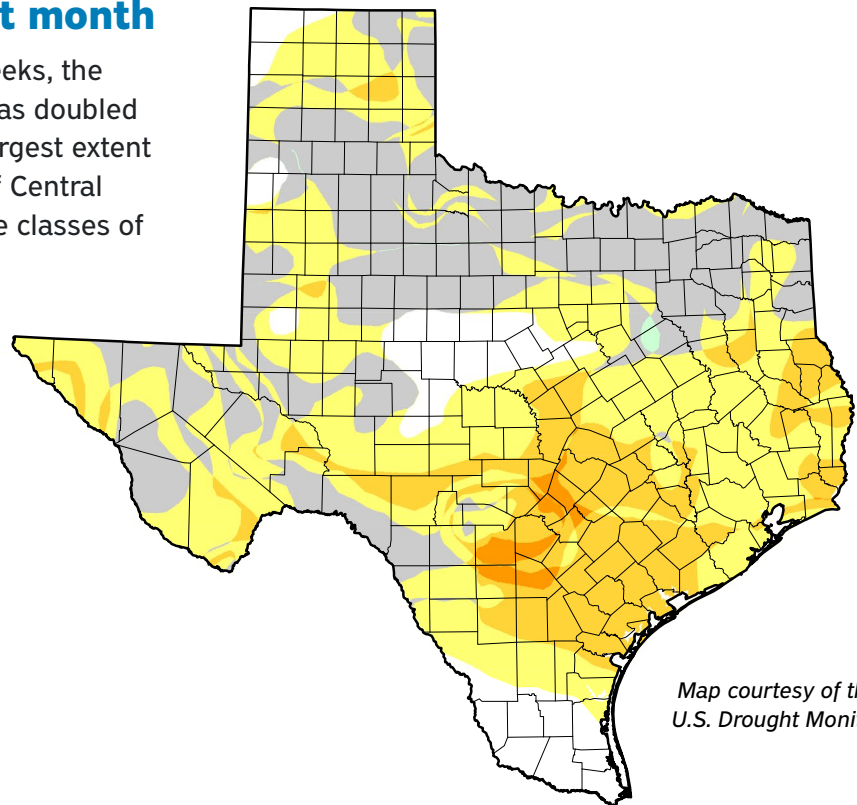
75% a year ago

Drought change in the last month

After expanding for four consecutive weeks, the area of the state impacted by drought has doubled since late September and reached its largest extent since late October 2023. Large areas of Central and East Texas experienced two or more classes of drought degradation in the last month.
