
DROUGHT CONDITIONS

Drought status


The Good: The past week saw general statewide improvements in drought conditions. The Bad: Reservoirs continued to decline in the Panhandle and Rolling plains. The Ugly: The National Weather Service put out a pessimistic three-month drought outlook: Continued and developing drought for the vast majority of the state.

Drought statistics

- 91% of state currently in drought
- 96% a week ago
- 83% three months ago
- 99% a year ago

RESERVOIR CONDITIONS (% FULL)

Reservoir statistics

- Statewide: currently 67% full
- 66% a week ago
- 68% three months ago
- 62% a year ago
- Normally 81% at this time

Key reservoirs

- Amistad (Lower Rio Grande Valley area): 45%
- Choke Canyon (Corpus Christi area): 46%
- Elephant Butte (El Paso area): 9%
- Lavon (Dallas area): 63%
- Livingston (Houston area): 100%
- Meredith (Amarillo-Lubbock area): 0%
- O.H. Ivie (San Angelo-Midland-Odessa area):
 23%
- Travis (Austin area): 39%
