

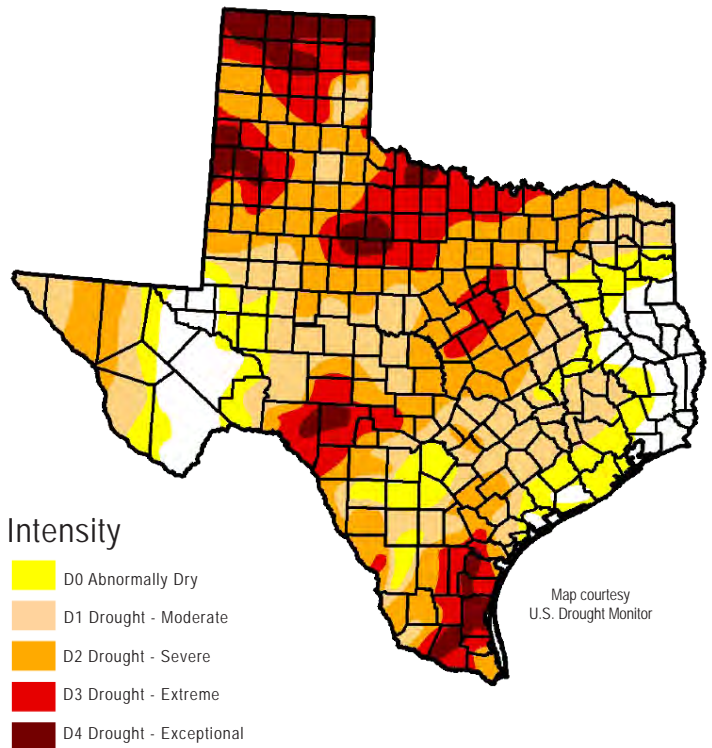
DROUGHT CONDITIONS

Drought status

Conditions this week are very similar to last week, although we did cross a depressing threshold: Statewide reservoir storage is currently the lowest since 1990 for this time of year. With a grim drought outlook for the next few months, we can expect to continue to be setting new lows.

Drought statistics

- 90% of state currently in drought
- 91% a week ago
- 85% three months ago
- 99% a year ago
- Normally 81% at this time



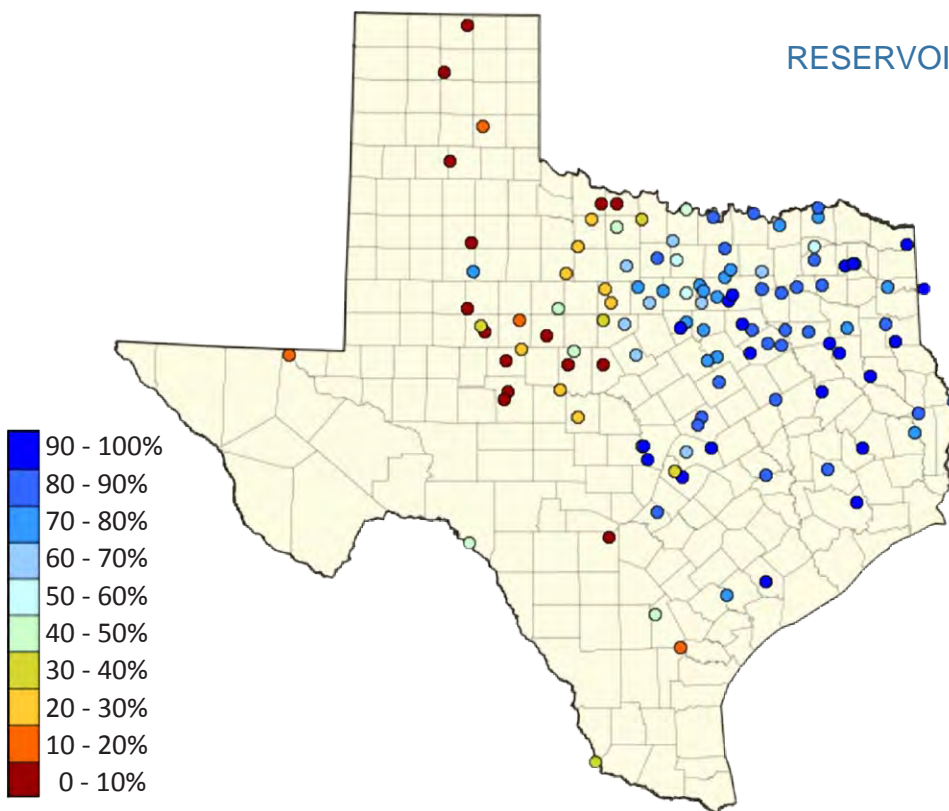
RESERVOIR CONDITIONS

Reservoir statistics

- Statewide: currently 67% full
- 67% a week ago
- 67% three months ago
- 68% a year ago


Key reservoirs

- Amistad (Lower Rio Grande Valley area): 44%
- Choke Canyon (Corpus Christi area): 46%
- Elephant Butte (El Paso area): 9%
- Lavon (Dallas area): 61%
- Livingston (Houston area): 100%
- Meredith (Amarillo-Lubbock area): 0%
- O.H. Ivie (San Angelo-Midland-Odessa area): 22%
- Travis (Austin area): 39%
