### DROUGHT CONDITIONS

### **Drought statistics**


- 90% of state currently in drought
- 90% a week ago
- 85% three months ago
- 95% a year ago

### **Reservoir statistics**


- · Statewide: currently 67% full
- 66% a week ago
- 66% three months ago
- 64% a year ago
- · Normally 82% at this time

### **Key reservoirs**

- Amistad (Lower Rio Grande Valley area): 43%
- Buchanan (Hill country area): 42%
- Elephant Butte (El Paso area): 10%
- Travis (Austin area): 39%



## FOCUS AREA: HIGHLAND LAKES



The Highland Lakes, consisting primarily of Lake Travis, Lake Buchanan, and Lake LBJ, have recently experienced near-historic lows. The only other time storage in the reservoir system was lower was during the mid-1950s (31 percent) and the mid-1960s (34 percent). System storage is currently at 44 percent of capacity.
