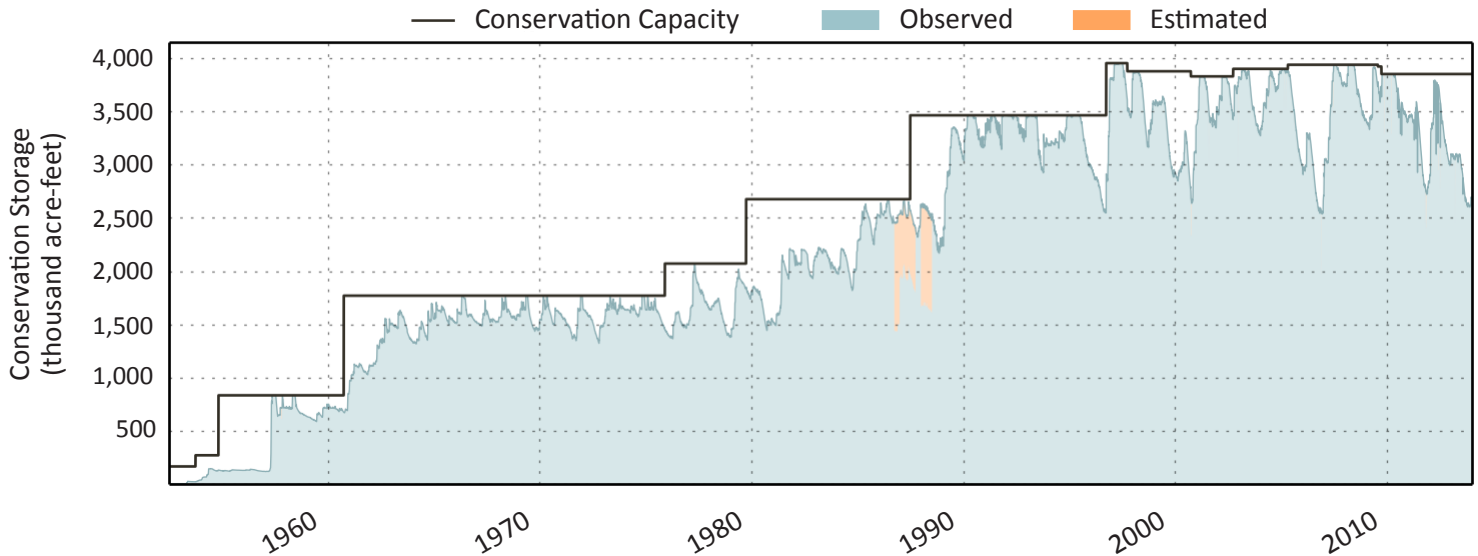


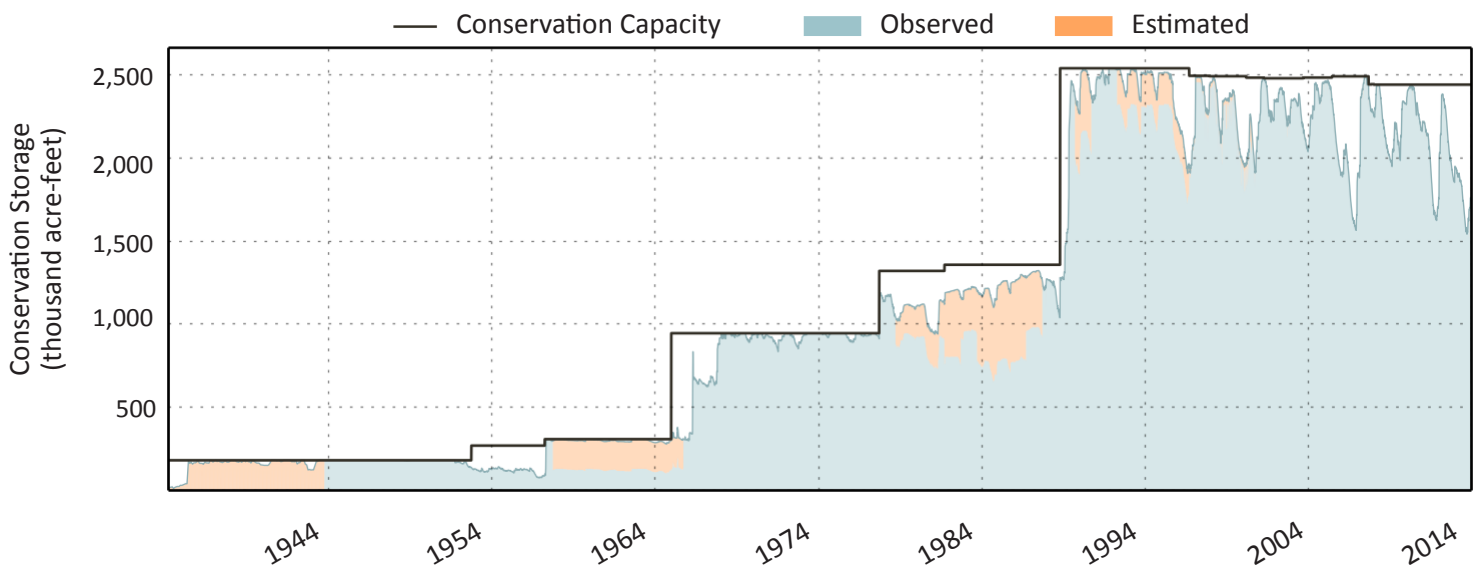
DROUGHT CONDITIONS

Although the U.S. Drought Monitor shows drought conditions abating in the Dallas–Fort Worth metroplex, reservoir storage has been “quietly” declining there over the past two years. Reservoir storage presently rivals what it was in 2011 at about 70 percent full. Although rains have brought lake levels up a wee bit in recent months, so far we’ve not been getting enough to fill the lakes.
