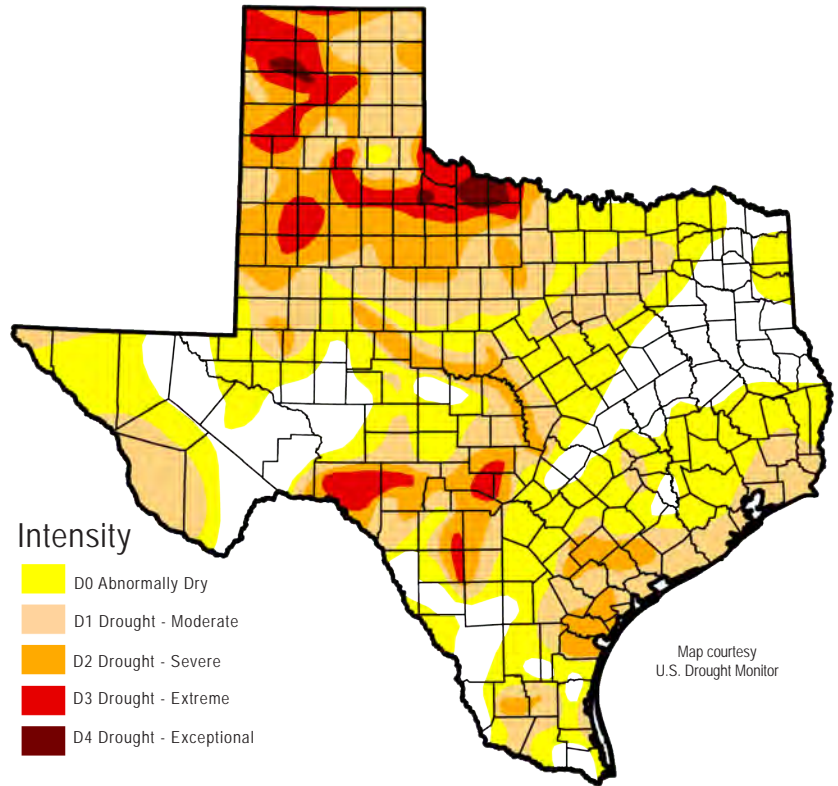


DROUGHT CONDITIONS

Continued deepening of drought conditions in Texas with much of the Gulf Coast now in moderate to severe drought. Statewide reservoir storage dropped 100,000 acre-feet (0.3 percentage points) over the past week with flat or decreasing levels in 19 of 20 municipal reservoir systems. January has been dry dry dry...

Current drought statistics

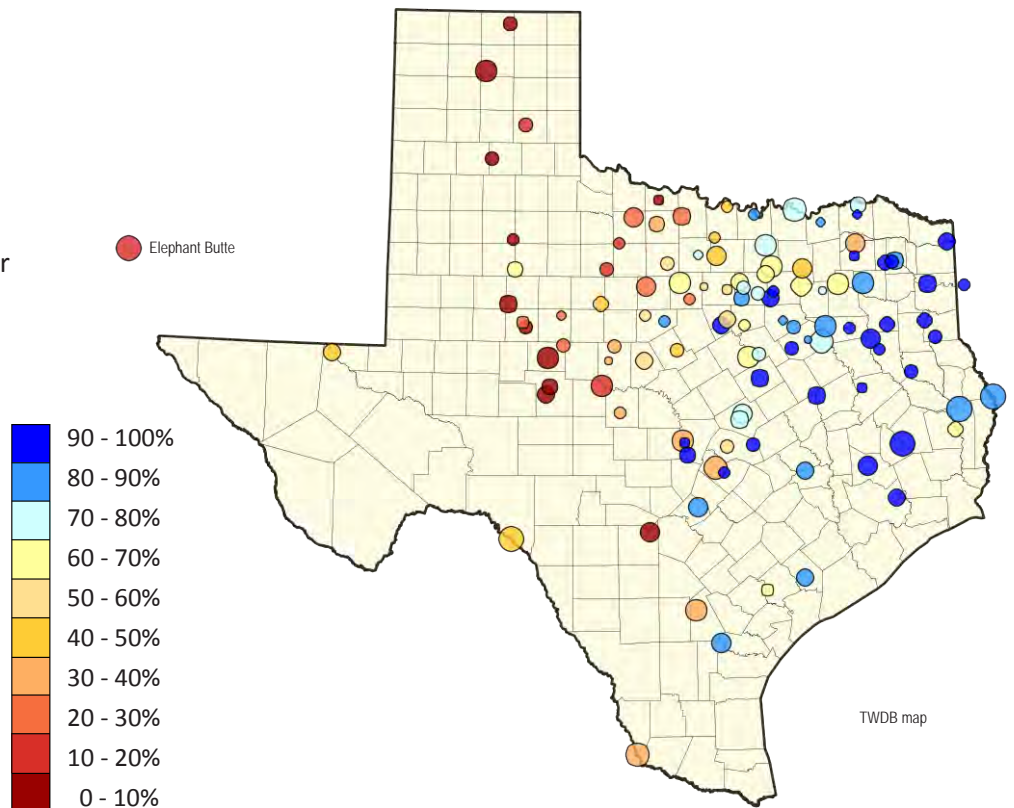
- 49% of state currently in moderate to exceptional drought
- 46% a week ago
- 59% three months ago
- 76% a year ago



RESEVOIR CONDITIONS

Monitored water supply reservoirs

- Currently 64% full
- 64% a week ago
- 62% three months ago
- 67% a year ago
- Normally 81% full this time of year
