

DROUGHT CONDITIONS

Continued worsening of drought conditions with a slight decrease in reservoir storage. Similar to last winter, we're not getting substantial winter rains to lift reservoir levels before the hot days of summer are upon us. Statewide reservoir levels continue to set record lows for this time of year that we haven't seen since 1990.

Drought statistics

- 54% of state currently in moderate to exceptional drought
- 52% a week ago
- · 50% three months ago
- 76% a year ago




RESERVOIR STORAGE

Low reservoir levels in the west; high reservoir levels in the east. In the central part of the state, we're seeing a continuing long-term degradation of reservoir storage.

Reservoir statistics (statewide)

- · Currently 64% full
- 64% a week ago
- 62% three months ago
- 70% a year ago
- · Normally 81% at this time
