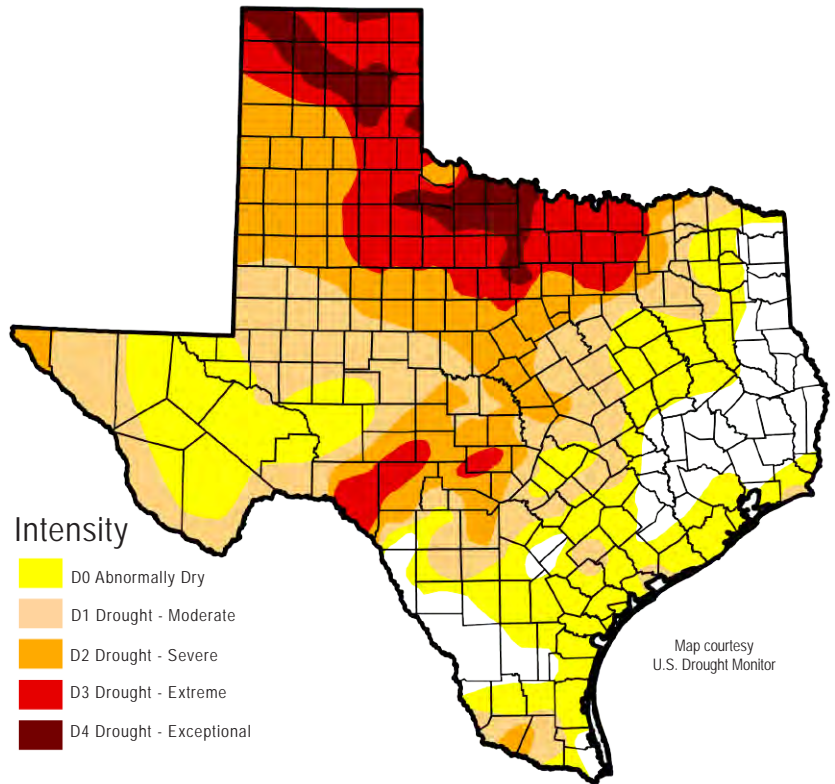


## DROUGHT CONDITIONS

The rain train has continued chugging across large parts of Texas, but the latest impacts on drought have been mixed. Just over seven percent of the state has come out of drought over the past week, but reservoir storage decreased by 100,000 acre-feet. And despite all the recent rains, the northwestern part of the state remains under extreme and exceptional drought conditions.

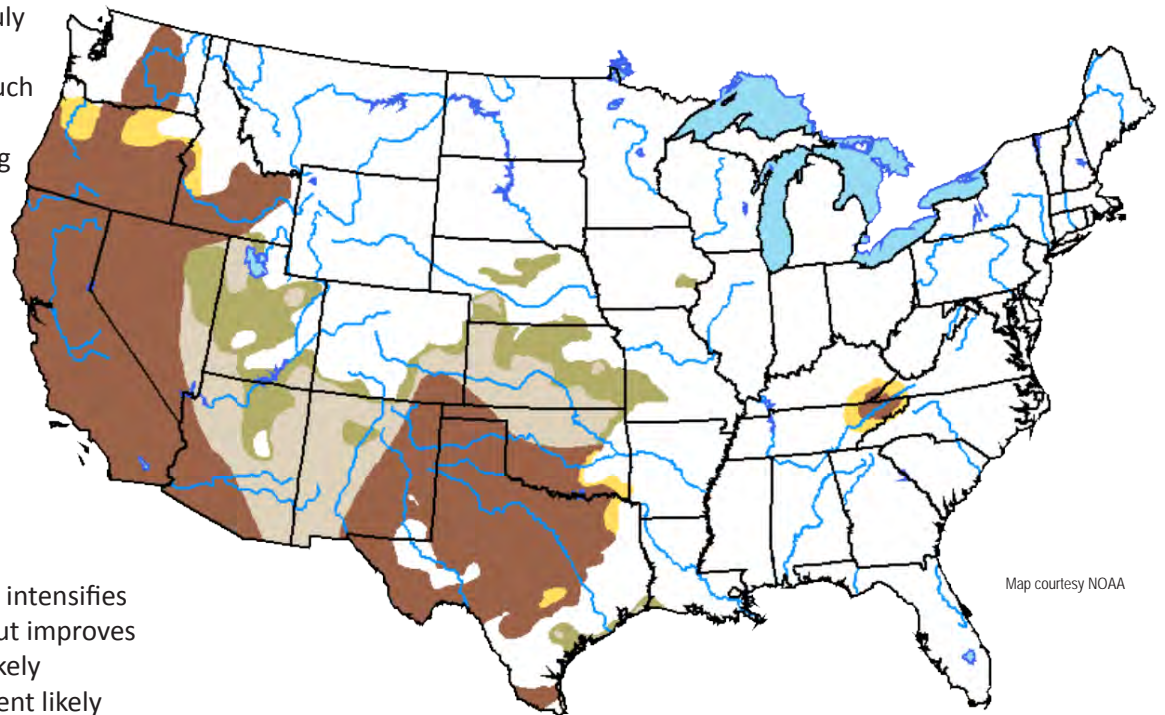
### Drought statistics

- 60% of state currently in moderate to exceptional drought
- 69% a week ago
- 67% three months ago
- 87% a year ago



## U.S. MONTHLY DROUGHT OUTLOOK

The latest U.S. Monthly Drought Outlook, valid through July 31<sup>st</sup>, shows continued drought conditions in much of west and north Texas with improvements along the coast.
