

DROUGHT CONDITIONS

The past week has been a mixed bag for drought with improvements in some areas and degradations in others. Reservoir storage declined, which is typical during the dog days of summer with higher evaporation, lower rainfall, and greater use. The big news is that most of state is expected to see improved drought conditions by the end of November.

Drought statistics

- 59% of state currently in moderate to exceptional drought
- 58% a week ago
- 72% three months ago
- 89% a year ago



SEASONAL DROUGHT OUTLOOK

The latest U.S. Seasonal Drought Outlook projects drought removal or improvement for much of the state by the end of November with the exception of the Lower Rio
