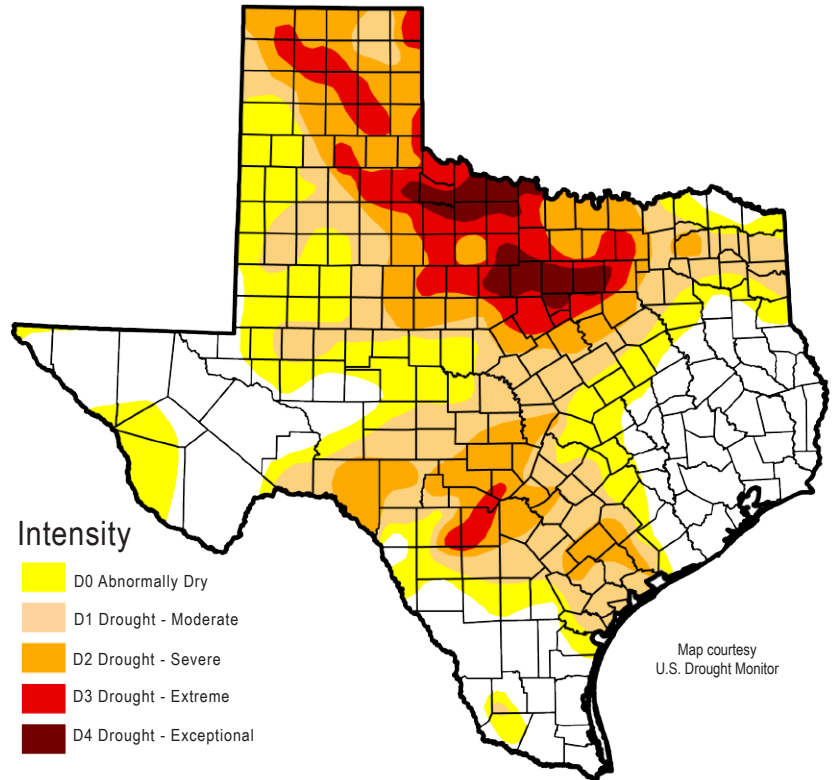


DROUGHT CONDITIONS

Not much change in drought or reservoir levels as we slowly transition from hotter and dryer conditions to cooler (and wetter?) conditions. The most recent U.S. Seasonal Drought Outlook, looking through the end of January, suggests drought improvement across the state and with drought removal at the fringes.

Drought statistics

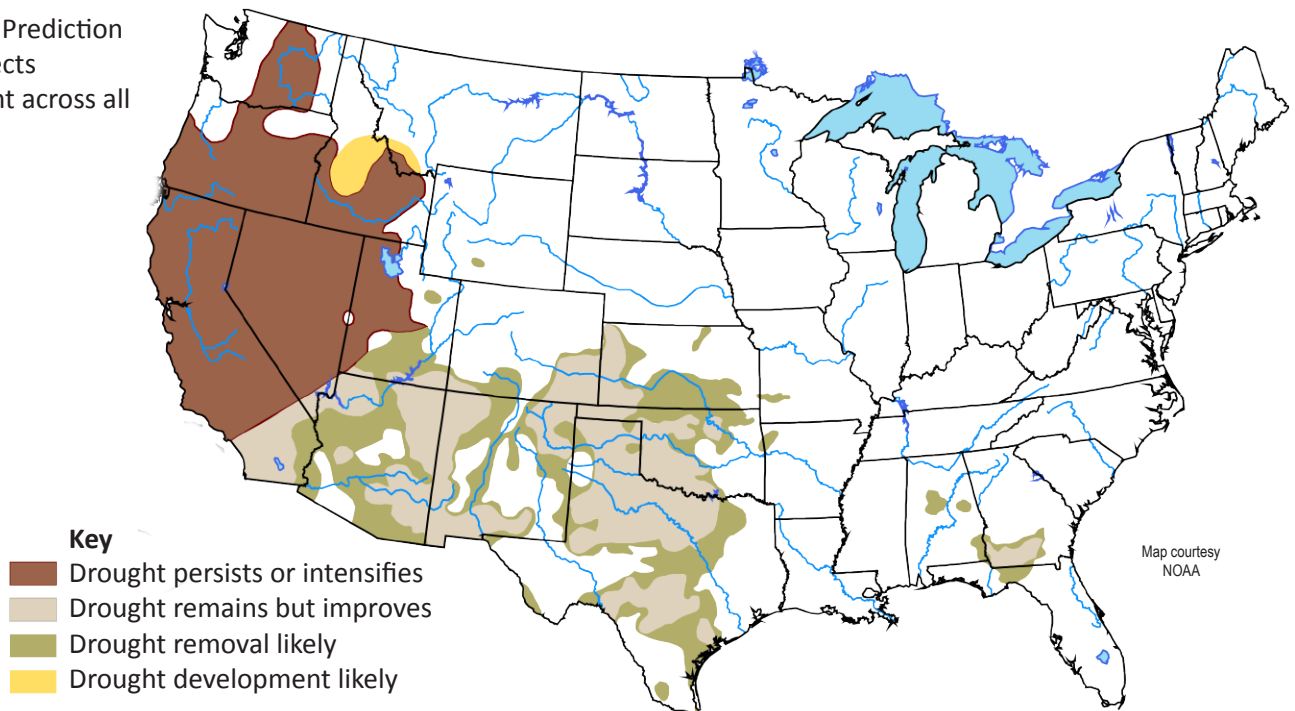
- 48% of state currently in moderate to exceptional drought
- 49% a week ago
- 63% three months ago
- 65% a year ago
