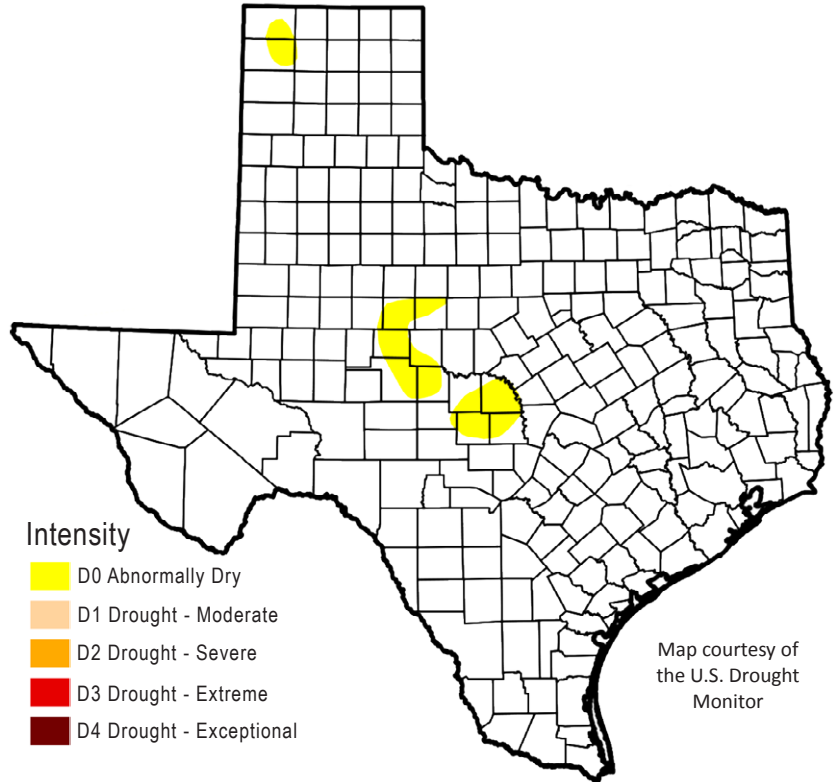


DROUGHT CONDITIONS

The big news this week? According to the U.S. Drought Monitor, there is no drought in Texas, the first time since April 2010. Remember that the Monitor favors soil conditions; reservoirs are still low in West, Far West, and South Texas.

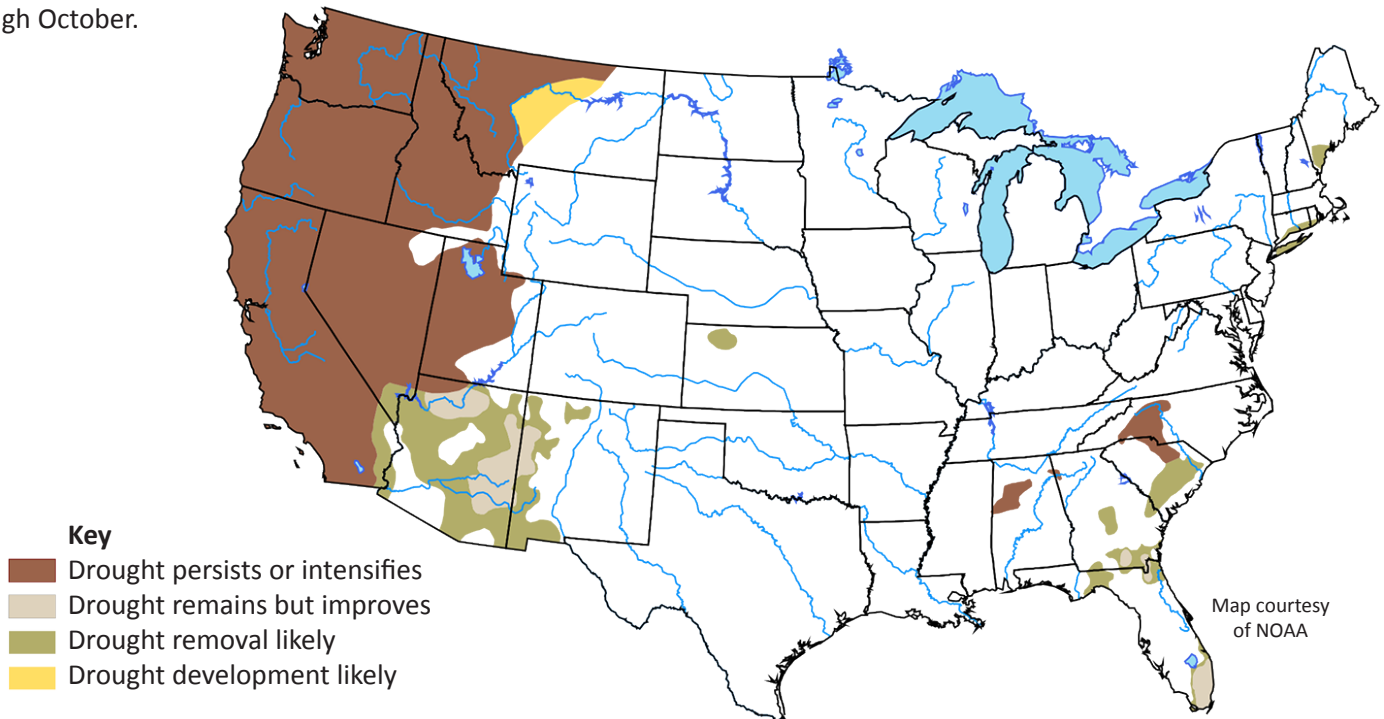
Drought statistics

- 0.0% of state currently in moderate to exceptional drought
- 0.2% a week ago
- 35% three months ago
- 63% a year ago
