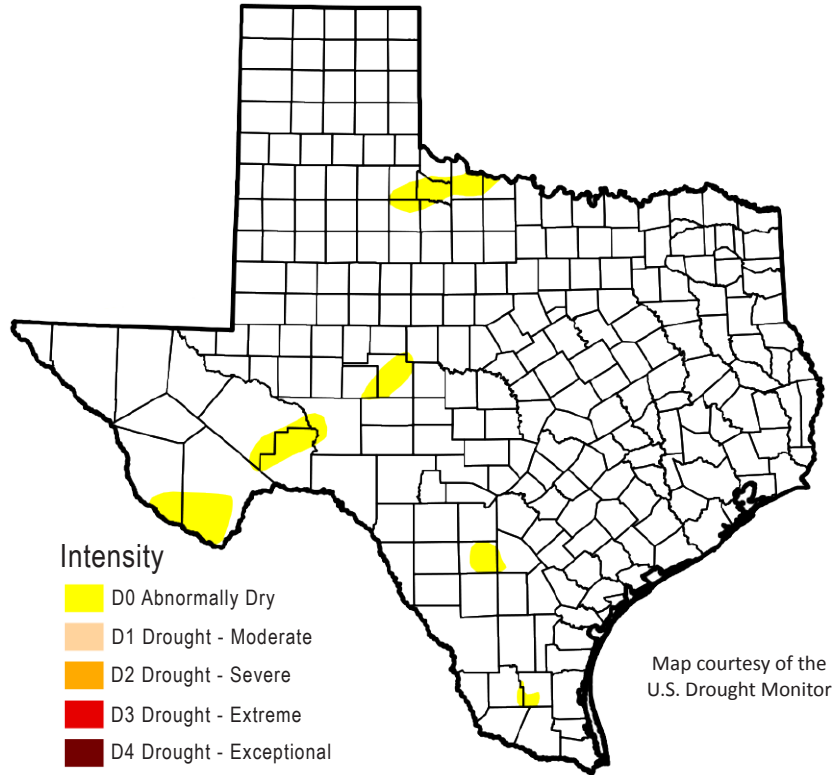


WATER CONDITIONS

We are, once again, according to the U.S. Drought Monitor, drought free! We still have half a dozen blobs of abnormally dry areas across the state, but even these are transitioning to better (and wetter) conditions. Recall that the Monitor favors rainfall and soil moisture conditions: reservoir levels remain low in much of the western half of the state.

Drought conditions

- 0% now
- 0.61% a week ago
- 25% three months ago
- 43% a year ago

Levels for the San Angelo area reservoirs (O.C. Fisher, O.H. Ivie, Nasworthy, and Twin Buttes) remain at near record lows showing that the water supply drought is not yet over in West Texas.
