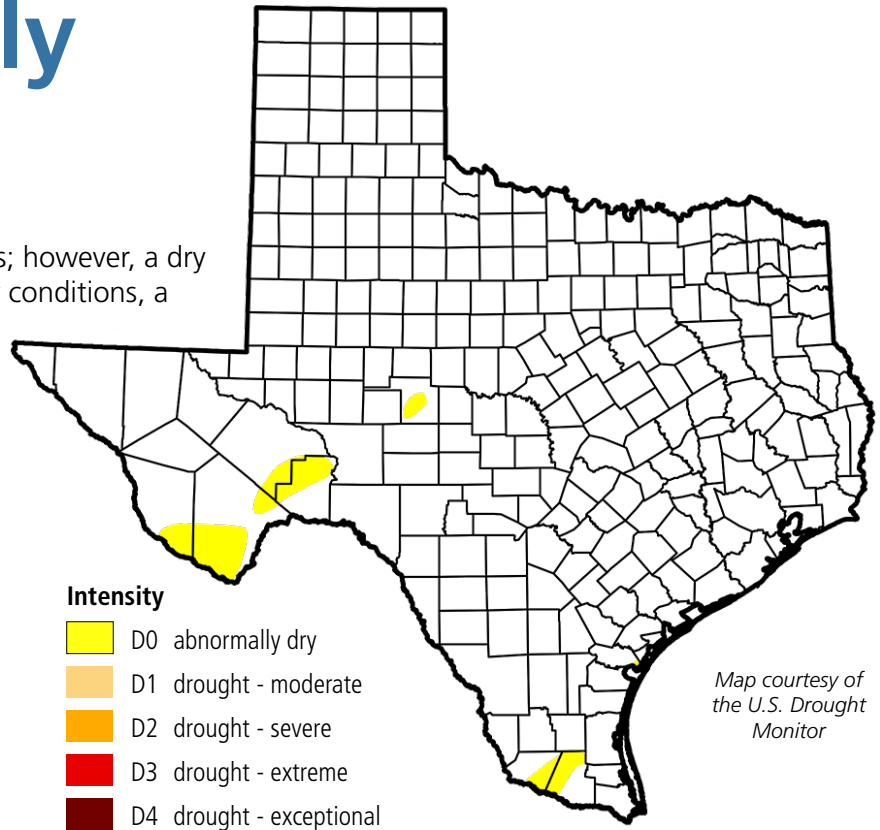

Water conditions

This is our 10th week of a drought-free Texas; however, a dry January has slightly increased abnormally dry conditions, a predecessor to drought. Statewide reservoir conditions are relatively stable, but many reservoirs in the western half of the state continue to be below normal.

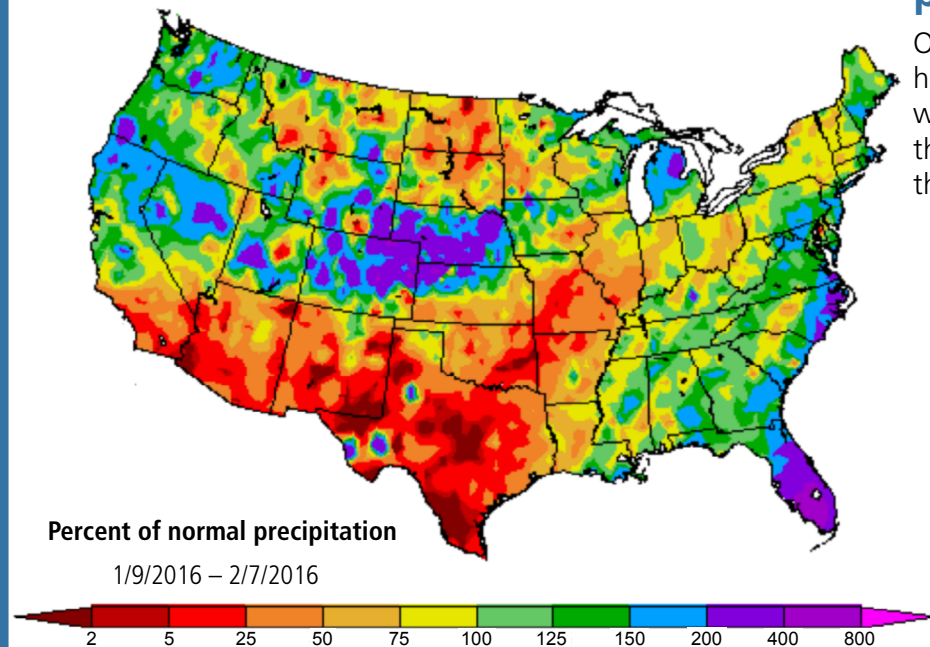
Drought conditions

- ◆ 0% now
- ◆ 0% a week ago
- ◆ 4% three months ago
- ◆ 39% a year ago



Percent of normal precipitation

Over the past 30 days, most of the state has received less than normal rainfall with much of the state receiving less than a quarter, and in some areas less than 5 percent, of normal rainfall.
