
Water Weekly For the week of 03/07/16 Water conditions Over the past week there was a slight uptick of drought conditions in the Corpus Christi and Lower Rio Grande Valley areas as well as a slight uptick in abnormally dry conditions in the state. Overall, since the first of the year, statewide reservoir storage has been steady with a hint of decline.
