
Water Weekly For the week of 05/02/16 Water conditions We saw some improvement in drought conditions in the Panhandle and in Far West Texas over the past week. Despite all the rain, statewide reservoir storage is only up slightly (5,000 acre-feet), mostly because many of the reservoirs in the eastern half of the state are full.
