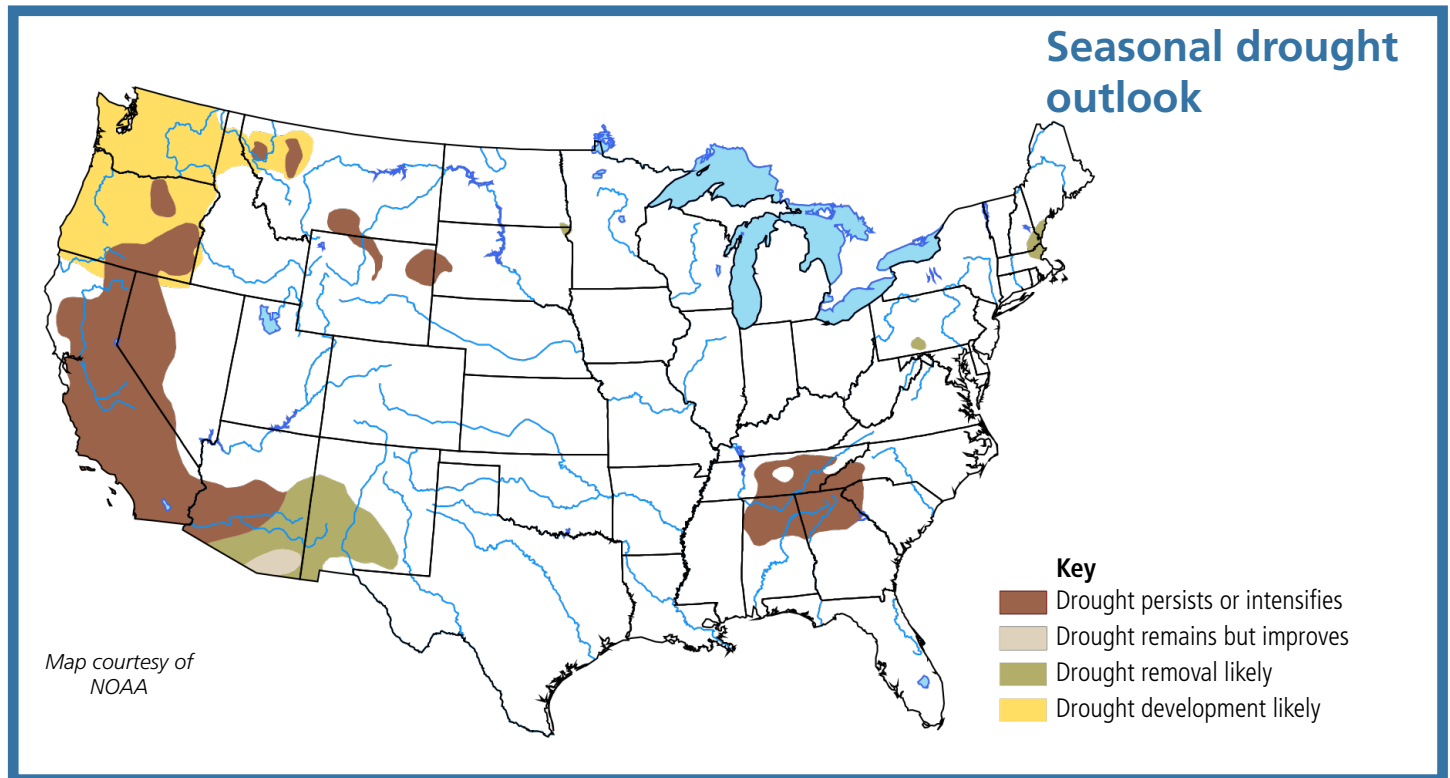
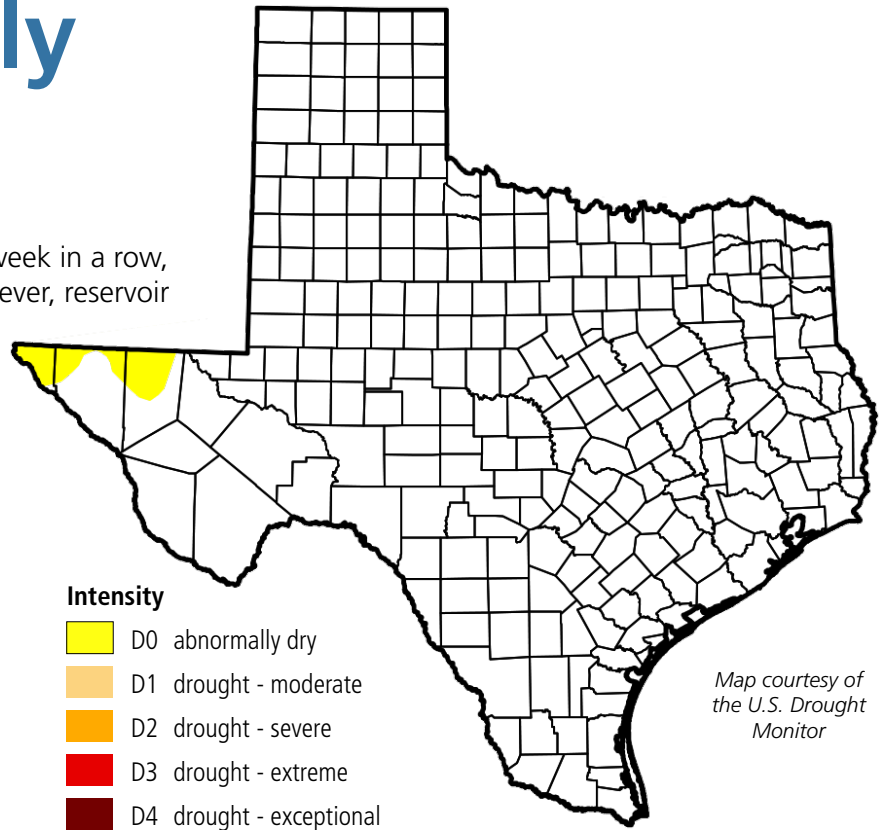

Water conditions

Texas remained drought free for the fourth week in a row, according to the U.S. Drought Monitor; however, reservoir storage remains below normal in the Trans Pecos, Edwards Plateau, and South climate regions. The most recent U.S. Seasonal Drought Outlook projects no drought in Texas through the end of September.
