
Water conditions


For the first time in nine weeks, drought has re-entered the water picture in Texas. Just like sweat blisters, drought spots

are mottling the state from the west to the northeast to the south. The seasonal drought outlook through October shows these drought spots persisting with a possible expansion in South and Central Texas.
