
Water conditions


After a bit of unusual August non-tropical storm-related rainfall, drought conditions have decreased from about 10

percent of the state to 5 percent, with most of the beneficiaries east of I-35. Even with those improvements, moderate drought has newly appeared in Hidalgo, Parker, and Palo Pinto counties, and severe drought has appeared in Kleberg, Nueces, and San Patricio counties.
