
Water Weekly For the week of 10/31/16 Water conditions


Drought conditions in northeast Texas have expanded and strengthened with severe drought afflicting 15 counties. Moderate drought now appears in areas

along the Gulf Coast and in the Panhandle. Almost 11 percent of the state is now affected by moderate or worse drought.

Statewide reservoir storage

Although drought conditions are settling into northeast Texas, reservoirs remain relatively full from earlier rains. Statewide reservoir storage is 84 percent full, five percentage points above normal for this time of year.
