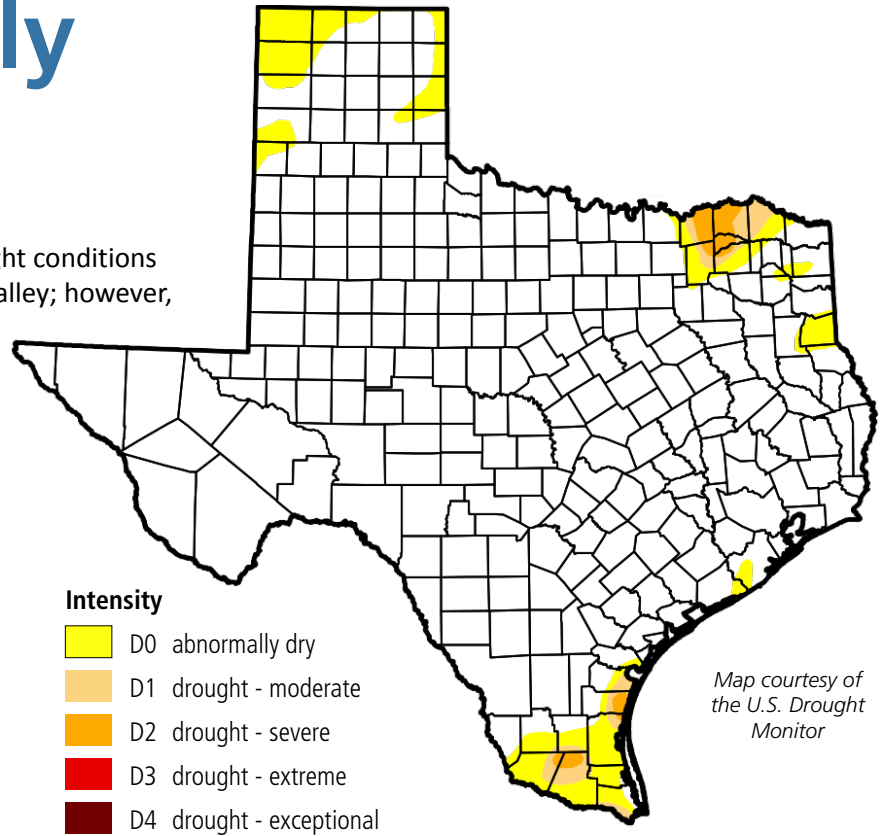

## Water conditions

The last week brought improvements for drought conditions in northeast Texas and the Lower Rio Grande Valley; however, abnormally dry conditions have newly crept into several counties in the Panhandle. Statewide reservoir storage is at 86 percent full, about 2.5 percentage points above normal for this time of year.

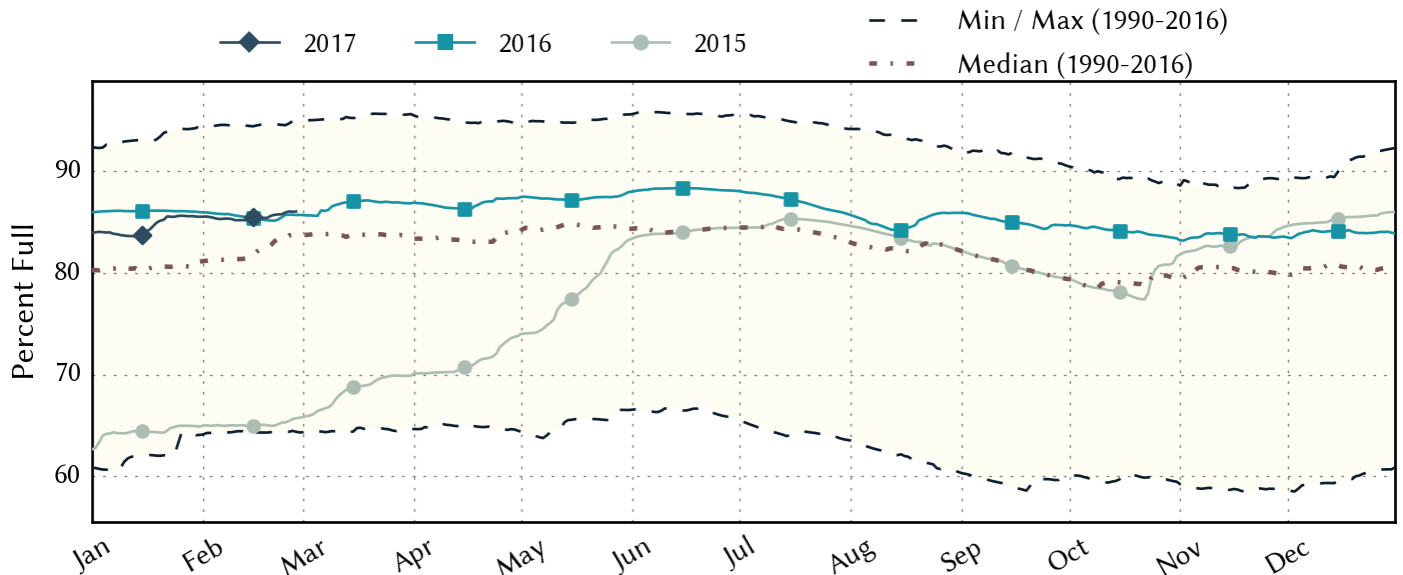
## Drought conditions

## Statewide reservoir storage

Ever since the rains in the spring of 2015, statewide reservoir storage has been near or above normal levels.
