
Water Weekly For the week of 05/22/17 Water conditions This week brings us quite an uptick in drought and dry conditions as our unusually dry May continues. Note that this map represents conditions as of Tuesday last week; therefore, it doesn't include the past week's rains, which have benefitted the northern half of the state. **Drought conditions 6**% now ♦ 2% a week ago Intensity ♦ 4% three months ago D0 abnormally dry ♦ 0% a year ago
