
Water Weekly For the week of 07/31/17 Water conditions The past week saw drought intensifying in both the Panhandle and in central-to-south-central Texas. Severe drought introduced itself to parts of central Texas and more parts of the Panhandle with moderate drought expanding in central and south central Texas.
