
## Water Weekly For the week of 09/25/17 **Water conditions** Our dry post-Harvey September continued through last week across Texas. This is good news for the Harveyravaged southeastern part of the state—the last thing those folks need is more rain. However, abnormally dry or worse conditions now cover 21 percent of the state, up from 8 percent last week. **Drought conditions ♦** 3% now Intensity ♦ 2% a week ago D0 abnormally dry
