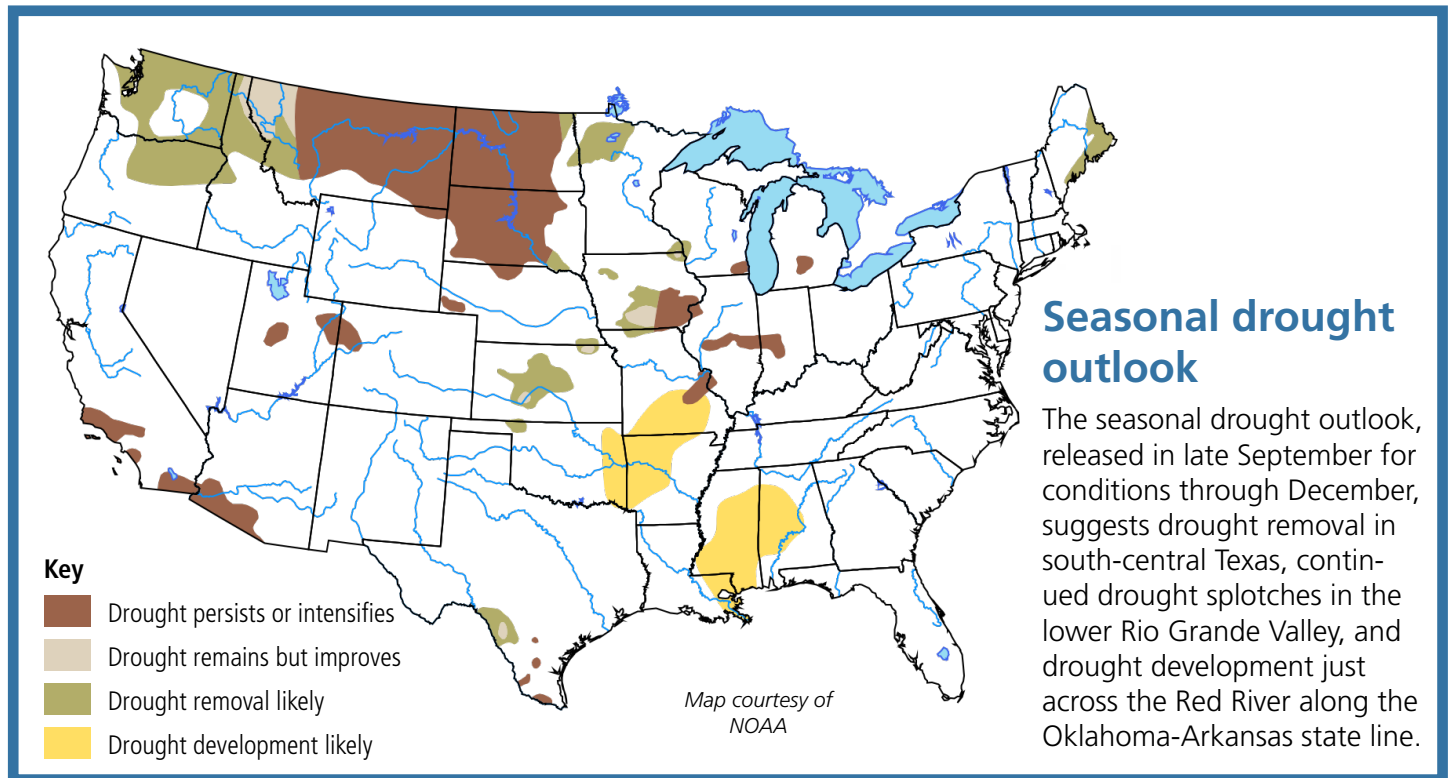
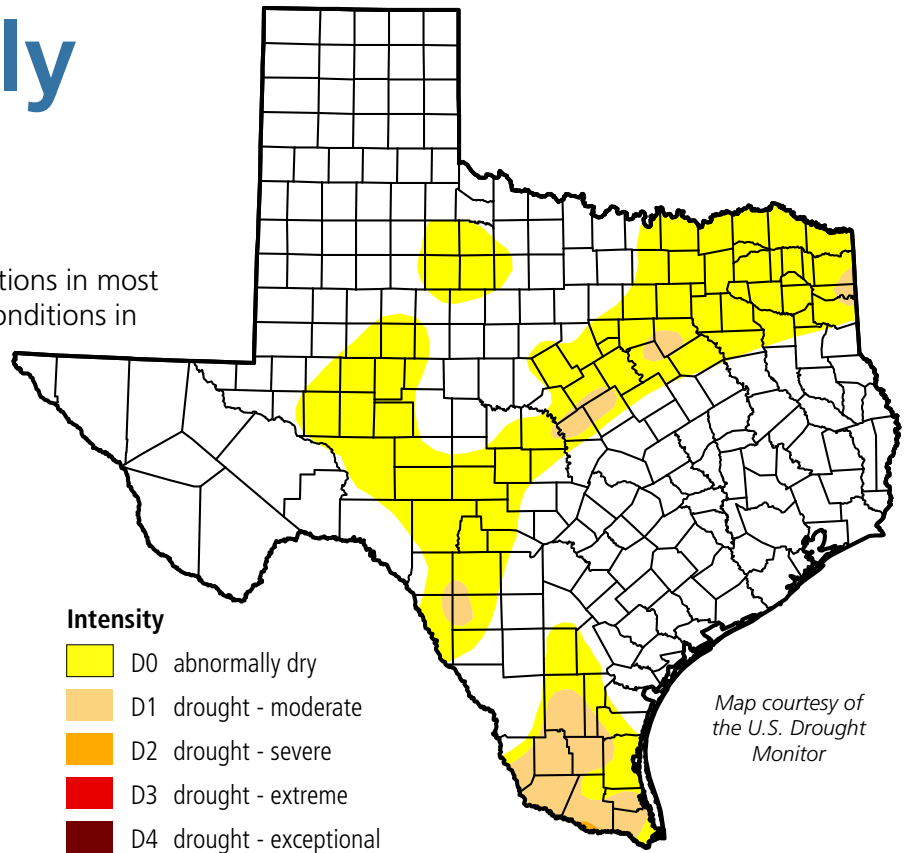

## Water conditions

Last week, we traded dry and drought conditions in most of south-central Texas for dry and drought conditions in north and northeast Texas. In addition, we saw moderate drought increase in the lower Rio Grande Valley. Statewide reservoir storage remains above normal at 3.5 percentage points above the median of 80 percent full for this time of year.

- ◆ 3% a week ago
- ◆ 6% three months ago
- ◆ 1% a year ago
