
## **Water conditions**


Drought contracted in South Texas and remains in only one county in that area. However, drought expanded elsewhere,

now present in 21 counties in the northeast. The city of Longview received almost 8 inches of precipitation in August, but less than 1 inch from September 1 to October 20.

## **Drought conditions**

- ♦ 3% a week ago
- ♦ 8% three months ago
- ♦ 6% a year ago
