
## **Water conditions**


Rains in northeast Texas decreased moderate drought conditions to a 50-by-75-mile rectangle in that corner

of the state. West Texas saw a spotty expansion of abnormally dry conditions that extend toward Central Texas. Conditions in the lower Rio Grande Valley remain the same as last week.
