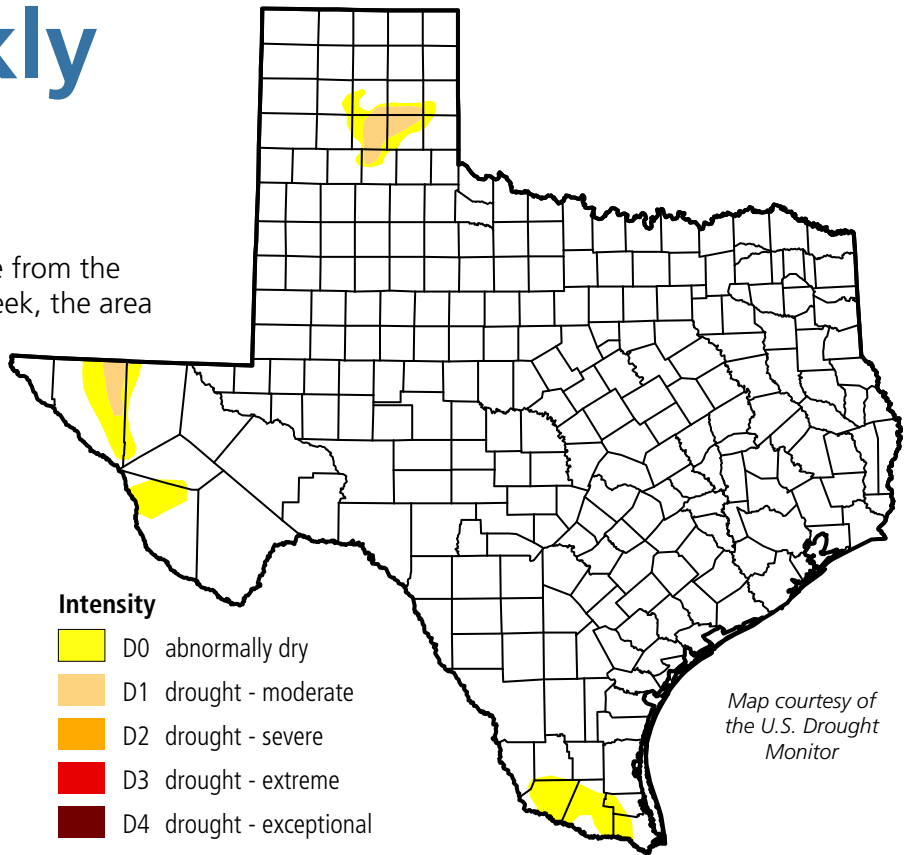

Water conditions

The latest drought map shows little change from the previous week. For the fifth consecutive week, the area impacted by drought is less than 1 percent of the state.

Drought conditions

- ◆ 0.8% now
- ◆ 0.8% a week ago
- ◆ 31% three months ago
- ◆ 26% a year ago



Drought timeline

In 2018, the area of the state experiencing moderate or worse drought peaked at 64 percent in both March and September. By mid-October, that value had dropped to less than 5 percent. As the year ends, less than 1 percent of the state is in drought.

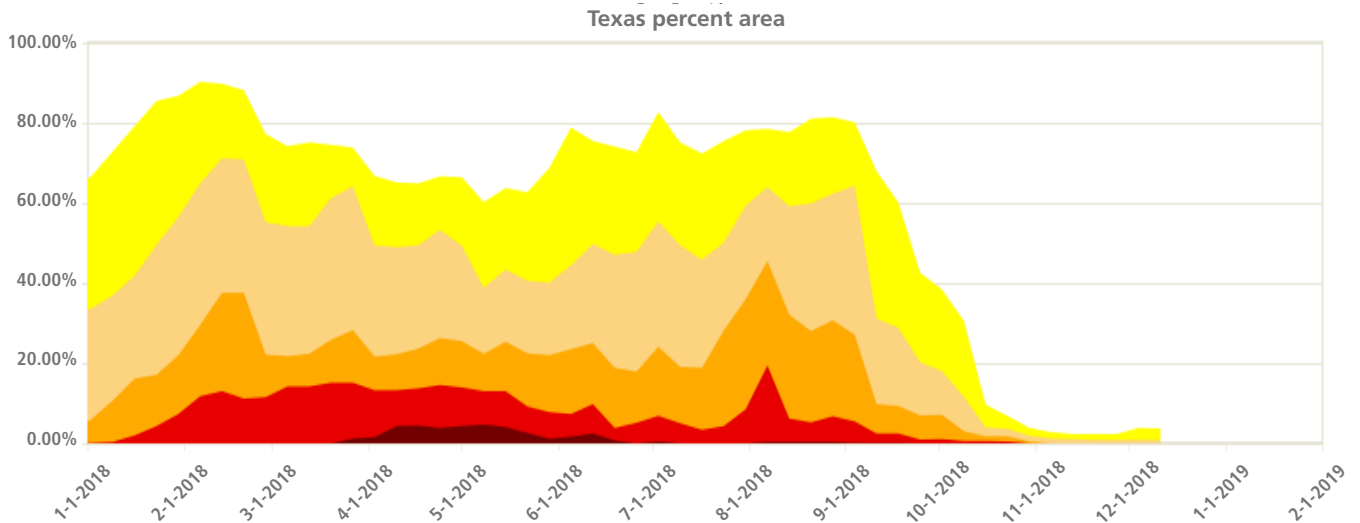
