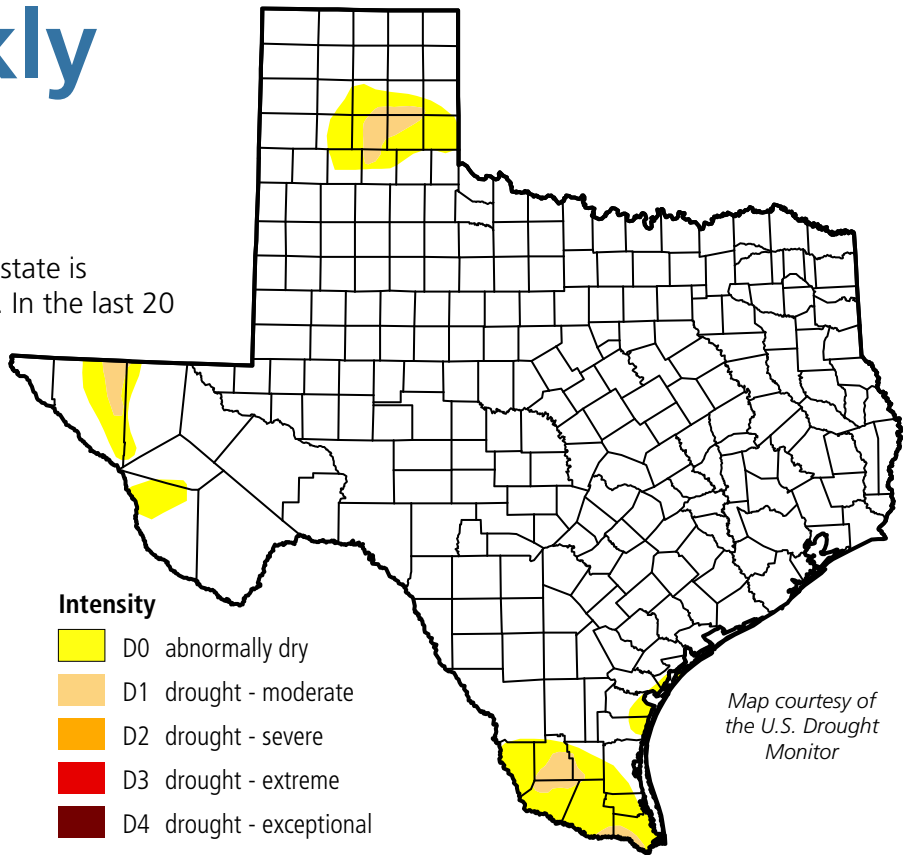

## Water conditions

As 2019 begins, less than 2 percent of the state is experiencing moderate drought conditions. In the last 20 years, the area of the state impacted by drought was lower at the beginning of only two other years (2005 and 2016).

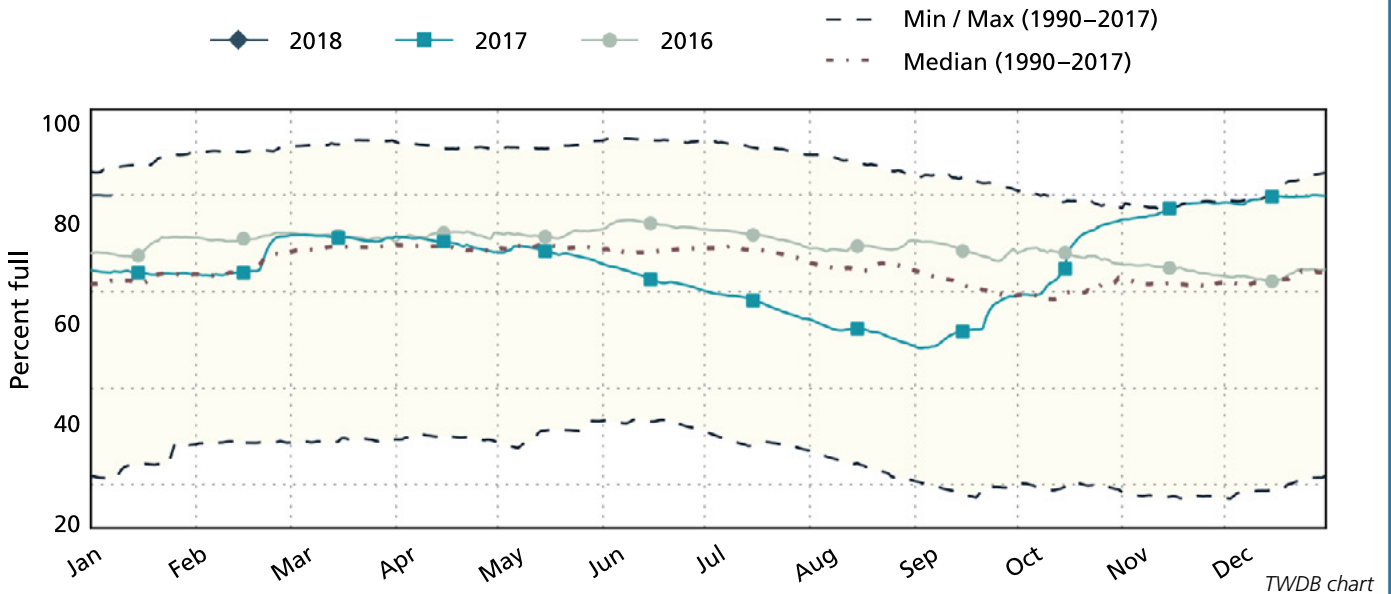
## Drought conditions

- ◆ 1% now
- ◆ 0.8% a week ago
- ◆ 18% three months ago
- ◆ 34% a year ago



## Statewide reservoir storage

Statewide water supply storage is currently 89.9 percent of capacity, 9 percentage points more than normal for this time of year. This is the largest value for statewide storage at the beginning of a calendar year since 1993.
