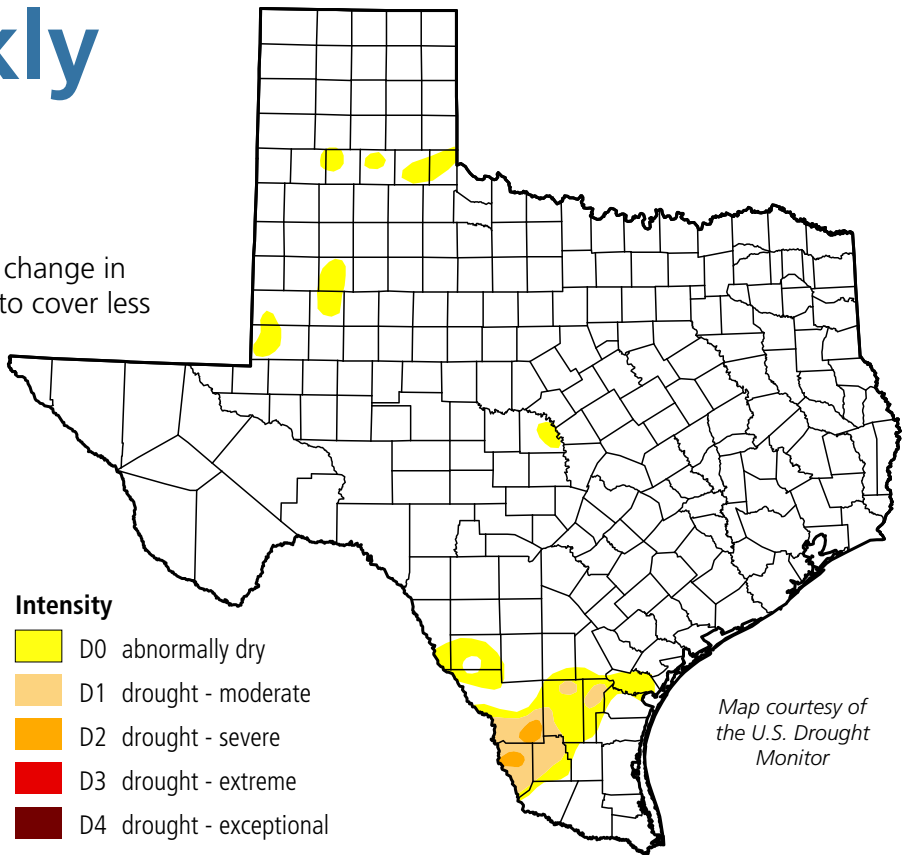

Water conditions

The latest drought map shows little overall change in conditions as of July 9. Drought continues to cover less than 1 percent of the state, but there are pockets of severe drought in both Webb and Zapata counties in South Texas.

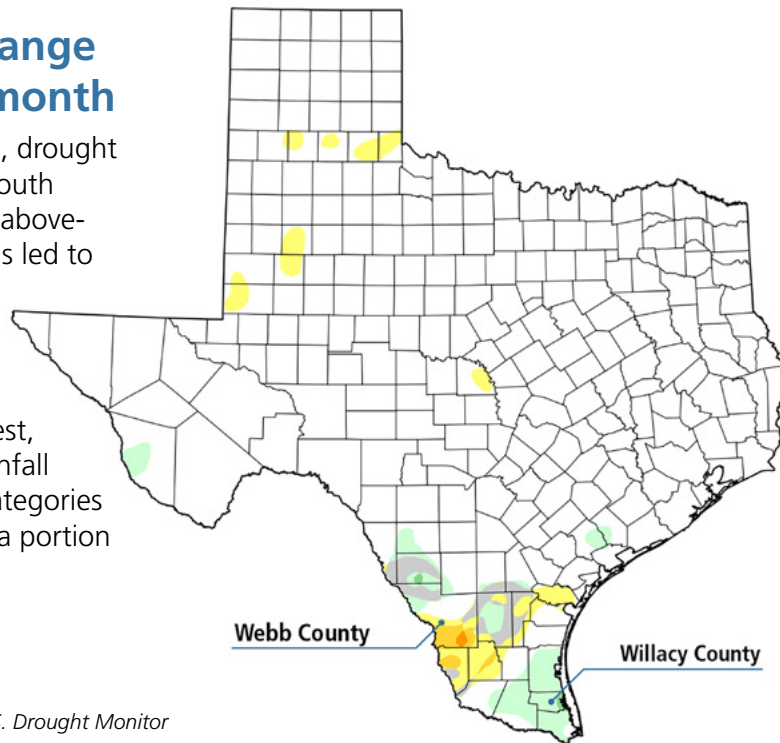
Drought conditions

- ◆ 49% a year ago



Drought change in the last month

In early June 2019, drought was confined to South Texas. Since then, above-average rainfall has led to a two-category improvement in part of Willacy County. A few counties to the west, below-average rainfall has led to three categories of degradation in a portion of Webb County.
