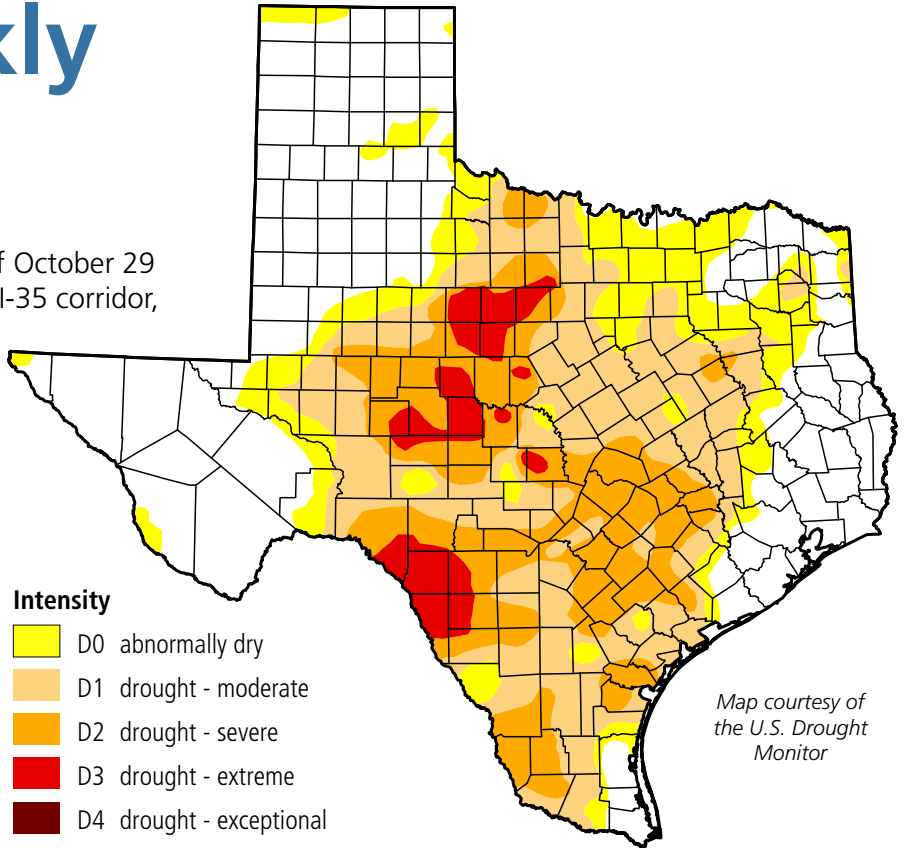

Water conditions

The latest drought map for conditions as of October 29 shows improvement along and east of the I-35 corridor, areas that recently received beneficial rainfall. Extreme drought continues to impact 5 percent of the state in several areas clustered near Abilene, San Angelo, and Del Rio.

Drought conditions

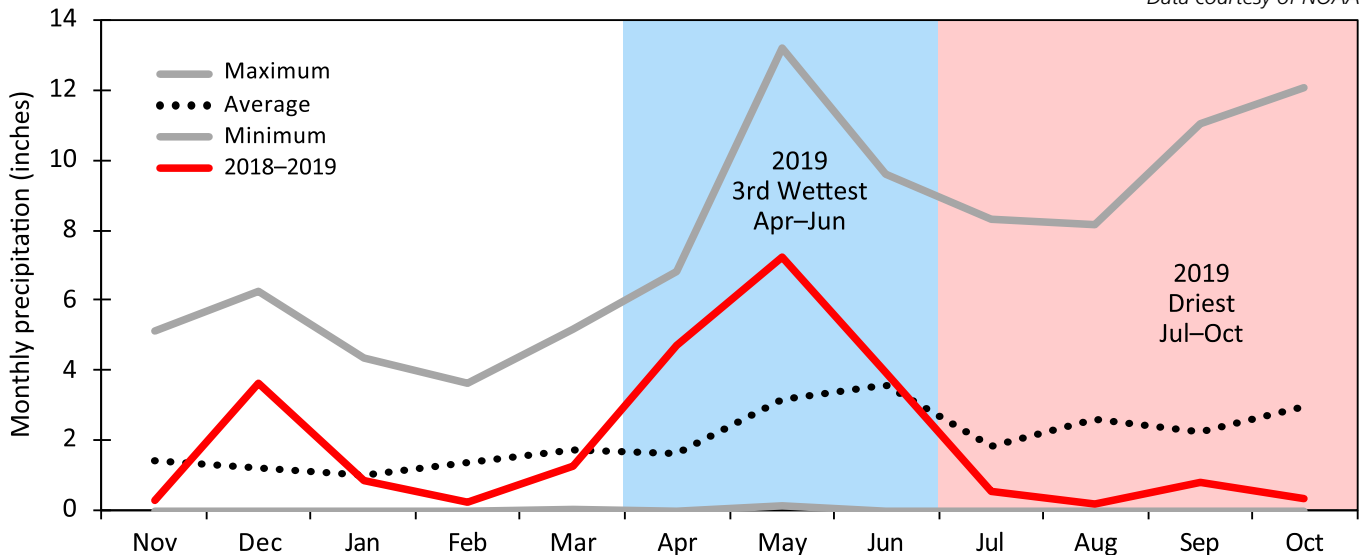
- ◆ 47% now

It's been a year of extremes for Abilene, which experienced its third wettest April through June in 72 years before having its driest July through October. The landscape near Abilene is now experiencing extreme drought.
