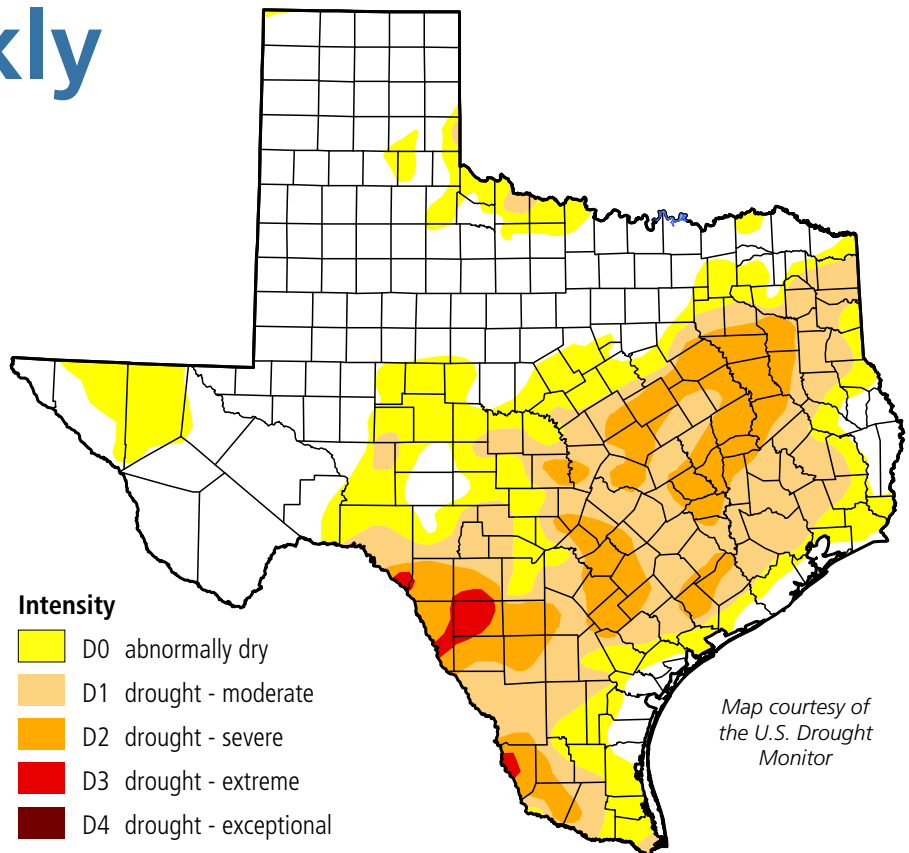

Water conditions

For the fourth straight week, moderate or worse drought decreased across Texas, falling one percentage point in the last week. But as of February 4, one-third of the state remains in moderate or worse drought and 12 percent of the state is in severe or worse drought.

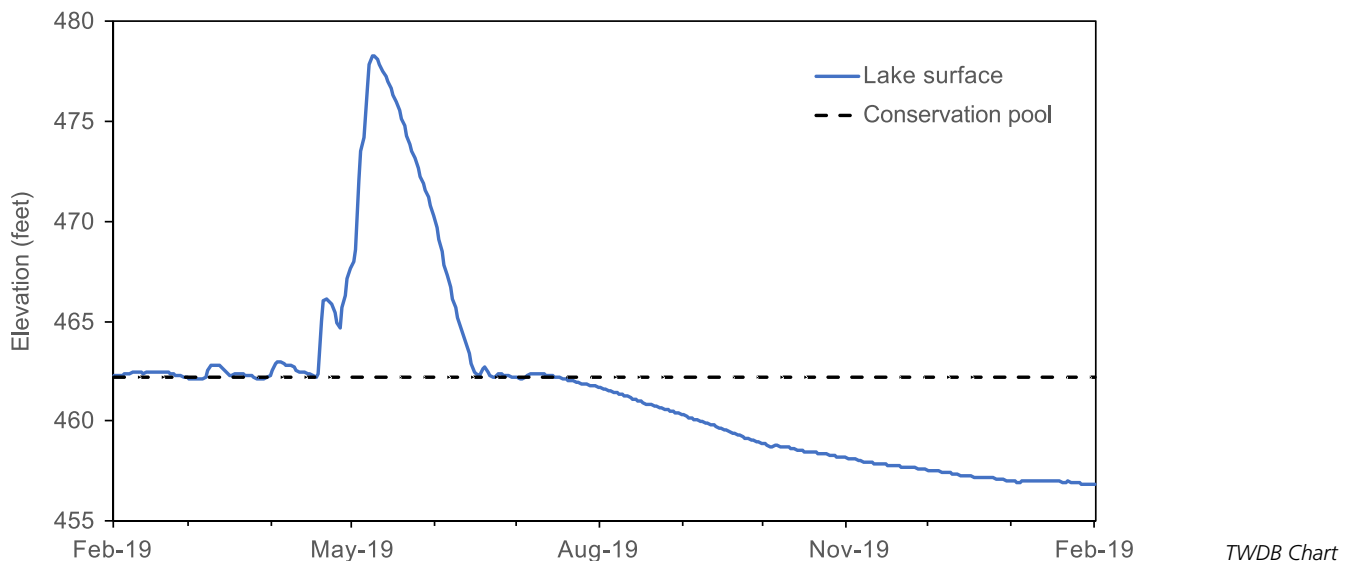
Drought conditions

- ◆ 33% now
- ◆ 34% a week ago
- ◆ 41% three months ago
- ◆ 2% a year ago



Lake Waco hydrograph

Lake Waco protects the city of Waco from both floods and droughts. While providing that protection, lake elevation has varied more than 30 feet in the last year. The lake is currently at 78 percent of its water supply capacity.
