


Water conditions

The most recent drought map for conditions as of September 28 shows continued expansion and intensification of drought. Much-needed rain that fell on parts on the state the last few days of September and the first few days of October may result in some improvements on next week's map.

Drought conditions

- ♦ 7% now
- ♦ 6% a week ago
- ♦ 9% three months ago
- ♦ 32% a year ago





September precipitation

Precipitation was below normal for most of the state during September. With 7.6 inches (150 percent of normal), Houston was one of the few locations with abundant rainfall. In contrast, Dallas received 0.3 inches (12 percent of normal), one of many locations with below normal rainfall.
