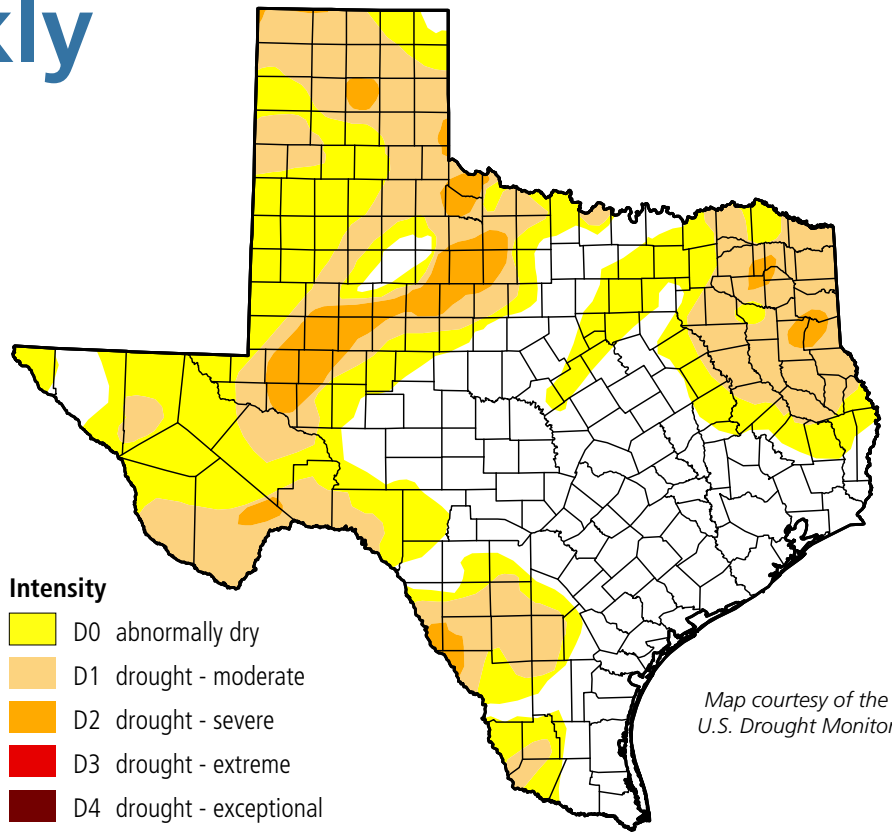

Water conditions

The latest drought map for conditions as of November 9 shows improvements in North Central and South Texas as well as continued degradation in West Texas. The net result is a small decrease in the area of the state impacted by drought, which is the first week-to-week decrease in nine weeks.

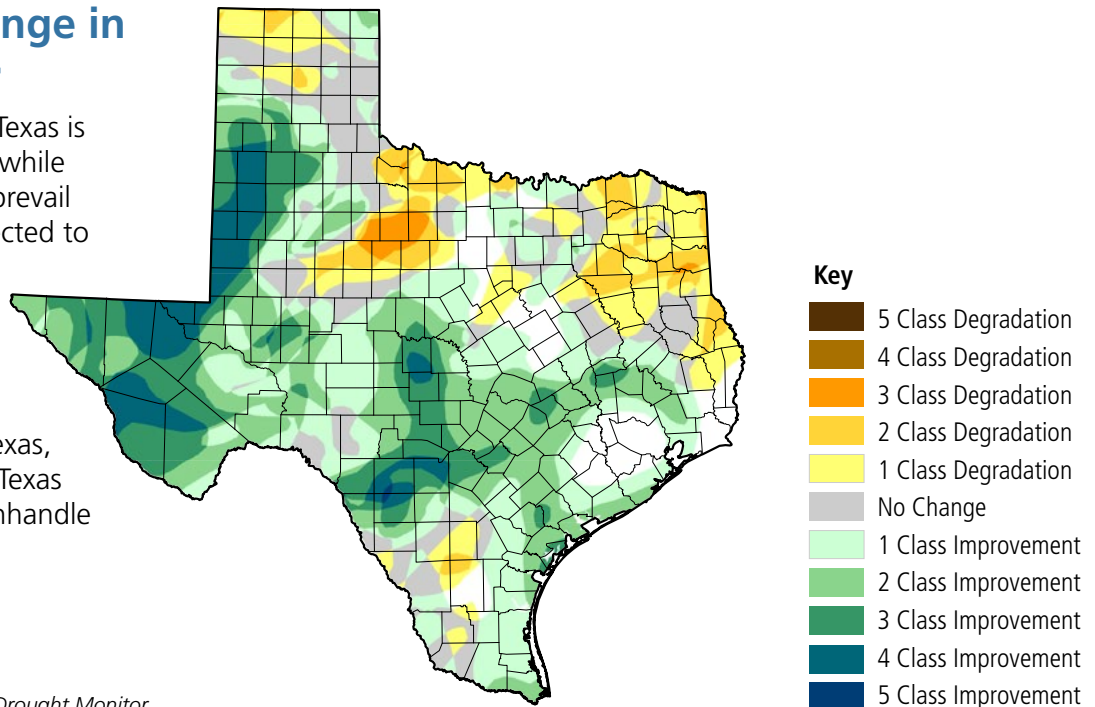
Drought conditions

- ◆ 32% now
- ◆ 33% a week ago
- ◆ 1% three months ago
- ◆ 57% a year ago



Drought change in the last year

Similar to last year, Texas is headed into winter while La Niña conditions prevail and drought is expected to expand. As of mid-November, drought conditions are better this year in West and Central Texas, but worse in North Texas and parts of the Panhandle and South Texas.
