


Water conditions

This week's drought monitor map, for conditions as of January 10, shows continued expansion and intensification of drought in Central and South Texas. The first half of January has been dry for most of the state. Even during this cooler time of year, that's a recipe for more drought.

- ♦ 73% three months ago
- ♦ 82% a year ago
