
Water Weekly For the week of **03/11/24 Water conditions** This is the latest drought map for conditions as of March 5. Canyon Lake storage

Since 1990, Canyon Lake on the Guadalupe River has experienced three extended lowstorage periods.
Conservation storage reached a low of 68.6 percent of capacity in September 2009, 75.4 percent in January 2015, and current storage is hovering around 60 percent.
